Pastor's Family Corner

The Ascension of the Lord - Mark 16:15-20

It can be very important whom we sit next to. Any family that has tried to sit down to a family dinner or packed the car for a trip has heard children argue at least once about who should sit where. To sit next to someone, especially if that person is important, is to have a place of honor. Jesus has this place of honor seated at God's right hand, but there's more to this metaphor than where Jesus sits in relation to God. To be in the place of honor is also to be in a place of power. Knowing people in powerful places can be helpful. Our children remind us of this each time we are called upon to referee a conflict. Jesus, honored at God's right hand, is a powerful ally for us. As you gather as a family, recall a time when there was a discussion, or perhaps even an argument, about where people were going to sit. Talk about why it might be important to a person to sit in a particular place. Observe that in today's Gospel we will learn about Jesus' place in heaven. Read together today's Gospel, Mark 16:15-20. Talk about what we might learn about the relationship between God and Jesus from today's Gospel and what we learn about Jesus' relationship to us. Observe that one of the things we learn is that Jesus continues to help us from this place of honor in heaven. Pray together the Apostles' Creed.

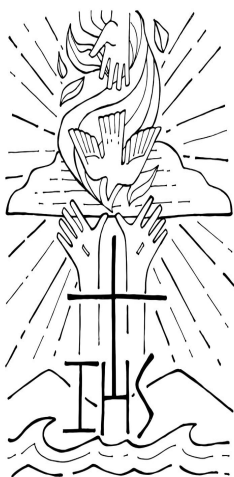

THE ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

The Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ is described in Acts of the Apostles, and is also noted in Mark 16:19 and Luke 24:50-53. Jesus refers to his Ascension in the Gospel of John when he tells Mary Magdalene, *"Stop holding on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father, but go to my brothers and say to them, I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God"*. Before his Ascension, Christ spent *forty days* teaching the Apostles and disciples about the Kingdom of God. The Lord informed them that they would receive power from the Holy Spirit to be his *witnesses* to the ends of the earth. The Ascension occurred at Bethany on the Mount of Olives. Christ's work of redemption has become known as the Paschal Mystery of Christ and was accomplished principally by his Passion, death, Resurrection, and Glorious Ascension into Heaven. The Paschal Mystery of Christ constitutes one action for the salvation of mankind, for Jesus *"was handed over to death for our trespasses and was raised for our justification"*. Jesus Christ made multiple appearances in several locations to his disciples for forty days following his **Resurrection**. For example, Jesus appeared first to Mary Magdalene in Jerusalem, to two disciples on the Road to Emmaus, to Simon Peter, to his disciples in the evening of that first day, and a week later to Thomas and the disciples. He appeared to James, and to Peter and the Apostles in Galilee. At the same time, Christ Jesus appeared to his disciples even *after* his Ascension into Heaven. Stephen saw Jesus *"standing at the right hand of God"* prior to his martyrdom. Saul experienced Conversion on the road to Damascus when he was blinded by a bright light and told *"I am Jesus whom you are persecuting"*. The Lord Jesus appeared to Ananias in Damascus, instructing him to baptize Saul of Tarsus. The *"Spirit of Jesus"* redirected Paul, Silas, Timothy, and Luke on the second missionary journey towards Troas, where they boarded a ship for Macedonia, the first recorded introduction of Christianity into Europe. The Lord reassured Paul to stay in Corinth after he had baptized Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue. Jesus actually appeared to Paul in the Temple of Jerusalem! The Lord stood by Paul in Jerusalem and advised him that he was to *"bear witness"* to Him in Rome. His final appearance in Scripture was to John on the island of Patmos in the Book of Revelation. His glorious Ascension signified the completion of his time on earth, which is celebrated by the Church forty days after the Resurrection and ten days before the Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit. Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us hope by promising that *"when I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also."*



Congratulations to these young people of our parish who have now received the Sacrament of Confirmation. May the gifts of the Holy Spirit be at work in each of them always.

Pastor's Family Corner
La Ascensión del Señor
- Marcos 16: 15-20

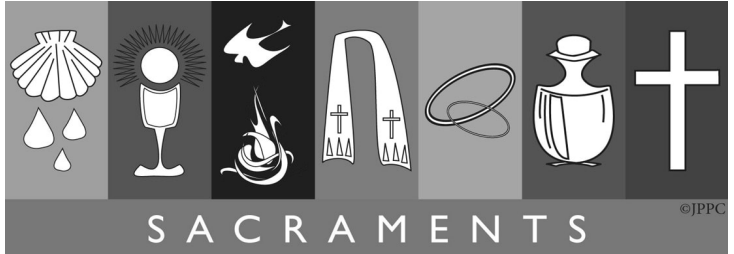
Puede ser muy importante con quién nos sentamos. Cualquier familia que haya intentado sentarse a una cena familiar o empacar el automóvil para un viaje ha escuchado a los niños discutir al menos una vez sobre quién debería sentarse y dónde. Sentarse al lado de alguien, especialmente si esa persona es importante, es tener un lugar de honor. Jesús tiene este lugar de honor sentado a la derecha de Dios, pero hay más en esta metáfora que el lugar donde Jesús se sienta en relación con Dios. Estar en el lugar de honor es también estar en un lugar de poder. Conocer a personas que se encuentran en lugares poderosos puede resultar útil. Nuestros hijos nos recuerdan esto cada vez que se nos pide que arbitremos un conflicto. Jesús, honrado a la derecha de Dios, es un poderoso aliado para nosotros. Mientras se reúnen como familia, recuerden un momento en que hubo una discusión, o tal vez incluso un argumento sobre dónde se iban a sentar las personas. Hable sobre por qué podría ser importante para una persona sentarse en un lugar en particular. Observe que en el evangelio de hoy aprenderemos sobre el lugar de Jesús en el cielo. Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Marcos 16: 15-20. Hable sobre lo que podríamos aprender sobre la relación entre Dios y Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy y sobre lo que aprendemos sobre la relación de Jesús con nosotros. Observe que una de las cosas que aprendemos es que Jesús continúa ayudándonos desde este lugar de honor en el cielo. Recen juntos el Credo de los Apóstoles.
