## Sunday of Divine Mercy, Year C

**John 20:19-31**

Our family life would no doubt be enhanced if we were able to transform Jesus' greeting into a central feature in our family's interactions. After his Resurrection, "Peace be with you" is the first thing that Jesus says to his disciples. This could be our daily family prayer for one another. In today's Gospel, we also hear that Jesus next breathed on his disciples and gave them the gift of the Holy Spirit. In Baptism, each of us has received the gift of the Holy Spirit as well as the forgiveness of sins. Peace is a fruit of the Holy Spirit. Our Baptism, then, invites us to share in the peace that Christ gave to his disciples and commissions us to share that peace of Christ by generously forgiving others as Jesus taught.

### READ TOGETHER

Today's Gospel, John 20:19-31.

### TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, think about gifts that you might receive together such as a coloring book and crayons, a book and bookmark, or an electronic item and batteries. Observe that Jesus also paired two gifts together in today's Gospel. Discuss the two gifts Jesus gave to his disciples: peace and the Holy Spirit. Ask: What were the disciples to do with these gifts? (They were sent as Jesus was sent by the Father to forgive sins.) Recall that we have each received Jesus' gift of the Holy Spirit at our Baptism and that peace is a fruit of the Holy Spirit. Observe that since we also have received these gifts from Christ, we are also sent to be people who forgive others as Jesus taught. Determine an action that your family can do to share peace and forgiveness with one another.

### Pray together

The Prayer to the Holy Spirit or the Peace Prayer of St. Francis.

"Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.'"  
**(JOHN 20:21)**

Peace - the first gift of the risen Lord. Just as Jesus sent the apostles out into the world, so too, He sends us. As disciples of Jesus, we are called to be compassionate and merciful; and not with just those who are our friends, but also with our "enemies." Think of someone in your life who you need to reconcile with. Call them right now or better yet, go visit them.



## La Divina Misericordia, Año C

**Juan 20:19-31**

Nuestra vida familiar sin duda mejoraría si fuéramos capaces de transformar el saludo de Jesús en una característica central en las interacciones de nuestra familia. Después de su Resurrección, "La paz sea con vosotros" es lo primero que Jesús dice a sus discípulos. Esta podría ser nuestra oración familiar diaria los unos por los otros. En el Evangelio de hoy, también escuchamos que Jesús luego sopló sobre sus discípulos y les dio el don del Espíritu Santo. En el Bautismo, cada uno de nosotros ha recibido el don del Espíritu Santo así como el perdón de los pecados. La paz es un fruto del Espíritu Santo. Nuestro Bautismo, entonces, nos invita a compartir la paz que Cristo dio a sus discípulos y nos comisiona a compartir esa paz de Cristo perdonando generosamente a otros como Jesús enseñó.

### LEER JUNTOS

Evangelio de hoy, Juan 20:19-31.

### HABLE JUNTOS

Mientras se reúnen en familia, piensen en los regalos que podrían recibir juntos, como un libro para colorear y crayones, un libro y un marcador, o un artículo electrónico y baterías. Observe que Jesús también emparejó dos dones en el Evangelio de hoy. Analice los dos dones que Jesús dio a sus discípulos: la paz y el Espíritu Santo. Pregunte: ¿Qué iban a hacer los discípulos con estos regalos? (Fueron enviados como Jesús fue enviado por el Padre para perdonar los pecados). Recuerde que cada uno de nosotros hemos recibido el don del Espíritu Santo de Jesús en nuestro Bautismo y que la paz es un fruto del Espíritu Santo. Observe que como también hemos recibido estos dones de Cristo, también somos enviados a ser personas que perdonan a los demás como Jesús enseñó. Determine una acción que su familia pueda hacer para compartir la paz y el perdón unos con otros.

### Orar juntos

La Oración al Espíritu Santo o la Paz de San Francisco de Asís.

"Jesús les dijo nuevamente, 'La paz sea con ustedes. Como el Padre me ha enviado, así los envío yo.'"  
**(Juan 20:21)**

La paz - el primer don del Señor resucitado. Así como Jesús envió a los discípulos al mundo, así también nos envía a nosotros. Como discípulos de Jesús, somos llamados a ser compasivos y misericordiosos; no sólo con nuestros amigos sino también con nuestros "enemigos". Piense de alguien en su vida con quien necesite reconciliarse. Llámelo inmediatamente o mejor aún, vaya a visitarlo.

# The Divine Mercy Message & Devotion

The Divine Mercy Message and Devotion to Jesus is based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God's mercy. Even before her death in 1938, the devotion to The Divine Mercy had begun to spread. The message and devotional practices are described in the *Diary of Saint Faustina* which is completely in accordance with the teachings of Church and are firmly rooted in the Gospel message of our Merciful Savior. Properly understood and implemented, they will help us grow as genuine followers of Christ.

In her diary, St. Faustina Kowalska wrote that Jesus conveyed this message to her:

*My Heart overflows with great mercy for souls, and especially for poor sinners...It is for them that the Blood and Water flowed from My Heart as from a fount overflowing with mercy. For them I dwell in the tabernacle as King of Mercy. (Diary, 367)*

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us — all of us. And, he wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.


The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

**A** - Ask for His Mercy.

**B** - Be merciful.

**C** - Completely trust in Jesus.

Spend time to learn more about the mercy of God, learn to trust in Jesus, and live your life as merciful to others, as Christ is merciful to you.



# La divina misericordia Mensaje y devoción

El Mensaje de la Divina Misericordia y la Devoción a Jesús se basa en los escritos de Santa Faustina Kowalska, una monja polaca sin educación que, en obediencia a su director espiritual, escribió un diario de aproximadamente 600 páginas registrando las revelaciones que recibió sobre la misericordia de Dios. Incluso antes de su muerte en 1938, la devoción a La Divina Misericordia había comenzado a extenderse. El mensaje y las prácticas devocionales se describen en el Diario de Santa Faustina, que está completamente conformidad con las enseñanzas de la Iglesia y está firmemente arraigado en el mensaje del Evangelio de nuestro Salvador Misericordioso. Correctamente entendidos e implementados, nos ayudarán a crecer como seguidores genuinos de Cristo. En su diario, Santa Faustina Kowalska escribió que Jesús le transmitió este mensaje:

*Mi corazón rebosa de gran misericordia para las almas, y especialmente para los pobres pecadores ... Es por ellos que la sangre y el agua fluyeron de mi corazón como de una fuente desbordante de misericordia. Por ellos habito en el tabernáculo como Rey de la Misericordia. (Diario, 367)*

El mensaje de La Divina Misericordia es simple. Es que Dios nos ama, todos nosotros. Y quiere que reconozcamos que su misericordia es mayor que nuestros pecados, de modo que lo invoquemos con confianza, recibamos su misericordia y dejemos que fluya a través de nosotros hacia los demás. Por lo tanto, todos vendrán a compartir su alegría.

El mensaje de la Divina Misericordia es uno que podemos recordar simplemente recordando ABC:

**A** - Pide su misericordia.

**B** - Sé misericordioso.

**C** - Confía completamente en Jesús.

Pase tiempo para aprender más sobre la misericordia de Dios, aprenda a confiar en Jesús y viva su vida tan misericordiosa con los demás, como Cristo es misericordioso con usted.


