Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time-

John 6:1-15

Parents may sympathize with the disciples' protests when Jesus asks Philip where food might be found for the crowd. In the responses of both Philip and Andrew, we hear feelings of inadequacy as they survey their limited resources in the face of such great need. We may sometimes share these feelings about our own material possessions or our emotional and spiritual resources in the face of our family's needs. This is a Gospel of hope for these times, which are all too frequent in parenting and family life. As Jesus made the five barley loaves and two fish sufficient to more than meet the needs of over five thousand people, Jesus will also work with what we have to provide for our family's needs. When we offer our efforts to God, we ask him to transform them so that they will be more than adequate to the tasks and needs before us.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, talk together about the things that your family needs, starting with the basics—food, shelter, safety, and so on. Continue by naming other things that a family needs to be happy and healthy—time together, cooperation, patience, and so on. Observe that sometimes we can feel like we don't have enough of the things that we need or want.

READ TOGETHER

John 6:1-15. Talk about how Jesus provided plenty of food for the crowd with just five barley loaves and two fish. We have faith that Jesus will also take what we have and make it enough to satisfy and fill all our needs. We ask for this blessing when we offer to God the work of each day in prayer in the Morning Offering.

PRAY TOGETHER

The Morning Offering, asking God to bless and make fruitful the work of each of our days.



Decimoséptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario -

Juan 6: 1-15

Los padres pueden simpatizar con las protestas de los discípulos cuando Jesús le pregunta a Felipe dónde se puede encontrar comida para la multitud. En las

respuestas tanto de Felipe como de Andrés, escuchamos sentimientos de insuficiencia cuando examinan sus recursos limitados frente a una necesidad tan grande. A veces podemos compartir estos sentimientos sobre nuestras propias posesiones materiales o nuestros recursos emocionales y espirituales frente a las necesidades de nuestra familia. Mientras Jesús hizo los cinco panes de cebada y los dos pescados suficientes para satisfacer las necesidades de más de cinco mil personas, Jesús también trabajará con lo que tenemos para satisfacer las necesidades de nuestra familia. Cuando ofrecemos nuestros esfuerzos a Dios, le pedimos que los transforme para que sean más que adecuados a las tareas y necesidades que tenemos ante nosotros.

HABLEN JUNTOS

Mientras se reúnen como familia, hablen juntos sobre las cosas que su familia necesita, comenzando por lo básico: comida, refugio, seguridad, etc. Continúe nombrando otras cosas que una familia necesita para ser feliz y saludable: tiempo juntos, cooperación, paciencia, etc. Observe que a veces podemos sentir que no tenemos suficientes cosas que necesitamos o queremos.

LEAN JUNTOS

Juan 6: 1-15. Hable de cómo Jesús proporcionó comida en abundancia a la multitud con solo cinco panes de cebada y dos pescados. Tenemos fe en que Jesús también tomará lo que tenemos y lo hará lo suficiente para satisfacer y satisfacer todas nuestras necesidades. Pedimos esta bendición cuando ofrecemos a Dios el trabajo de cada día en oración en la Ofrenda de la Mañana.

OREN JUNTOS

La Ofrenda de la Mañana, pidiendo a Dios que bendiga y haga fructífera la obra de cada uno de nuestros días.

"There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?" JOHN 6:9

The miracle of the Loaves and Fishes carries two important messages. First, no matter how little we have, we always have enough to share. Second, Christ can take our humble gifts and do great things with them if we are just willing to let Him. Nothing is impossible with God. All of our gifts, big or small, were given to us for a reason. No gift is too small or insignificant!

There has been ongoing confusion about what the "Bishop's Faith Appeal" is all about. This is mostly due to the word "bishop" being included in the title of the annual campaign. There is an intention to soon change the title but for now, we must simply educate everyone in an effort to correct this misconception. The funds raised by the BFA are NOT going to Bishop Toups but to the various ministries within the diocese he shepherds. It is an appeal BY our Bishop to support these ministries. It is NOT an appeal for him to receive anything. Please support these ministries as it is vital to our faith community in Southeast Texas and it is our duty as Catholics to support our larger faith community, not simply our own parish.

Your donation to the Bishop's Faith Appeal helps various ministries within the diocese to carry out the Gospel message to help the poor, the lost, the vulnerable and the unchurched. We are one faith community and the BFA helps us act as such to those in need of life changing miracles within our diocese and beyond. This year's theme is "For those who love God, all things work together for the good." taken from Paul's letter to the Romans 8:28. All things will work together as we love and care for one another. Imagine a community where no one goes hungry, where all feel welcomed, where those who mourn are comforted and where those who are lost learn of the healing love of Jesus. This kind of community is established when we work together for the good. 




Children's Challenge Desafio Para Los Niños


