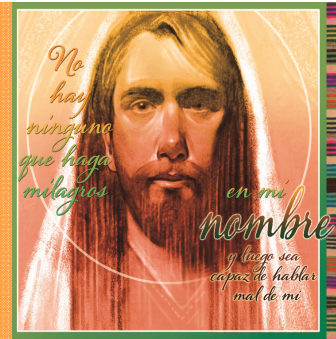

**Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
Mark 9:38-43,45,47-48**

The second part of today's Gospel contains a strong message for those who share the responsibility of fostering faith. It is indeed an awesome responsibility. Today's Gospel reminds us that faith is a lifelong journey toward God. We don't always get it all or even get it right. But we pray for the grace to acknowledge and build upon even the smallest signs of faith, in ourselves and in others. There are plenty of obstacles that might prevent the growth of faith. Let us pray that we are not contributing to the obstacles that might hinder another person's faith in Jesus. As you gather as a family, observe that there are things in our lives that nurture our faith and things that can hinder it.

**TALK TOGETHER**

about some of the things that nurture our faith—healthy family relationships, healthy friendships, good literature, and so on. Name some of the things that might be an obstacle to faith—unhealthy relationships, scandals, and so on. Observe that Jesus teaches us in today's Gospel that we are to do everything we can to help one another have faith in Jesus and do all that we can to avoid creating obstacles that might hinder another person's faith.

**READ TOGETHER**

today's Gospel, Mark 9:38-43,45,47-48. Conclude by praying together that we will be a family that helps each other grow in faith.

**PRAY TOGETHER**

today's psalm, Psalm 19, or the Lord's Prayer.

Marcos 9:38-43,45,47-48**

La segunda parte del Evangelio de hoy contiene un mensaje contundente para quienes comparten la responsabilidad de fomentar la fe. De hecho, es una gran responsabilidad. El evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que la fe es un viaje de por vida hacia Dios. No siempre lo hacemos todo o ni siquiera lo hacemos bien. Pero oramos por la gracia de reconocer y construir sobre los más pequeños señales de fe, en nosotros mismos y en los demás. Hay muchos obstáculos que pueden impedir el crecimiento de la fe. Oremos para que no contribuyamos a los obstáculos que puedan obstaculizar la fe de otra persona en Jesús. Al reunirse como familia, observe que hay cosas en nuestra vida que nutren nuestra fe y cosas que pueden obstaculizarla.

**HABLAR JUNTOS**

sobre algunas de las cosas que nutren nuestra fe: relaciones familiares saludables, amistades saludables, buena literatura, etc. Nombra algunas de las cosas que podrían ser un obstáculo para la fe: relaciones poco saludables, escándalos, etc. Observe que Jesús nos enseña en el Evangelio de hoy que debemos hacer todo lo posible para ayudarnos unos a otros a tener fe en Jesús y hacer todo lo posible para evitar crear obstáculos que puedan entorpecer la fe de otra persona.

**LEER JUNTOS**

Evangelio de hoy, Marcos 9: 38-43,45,47-48. Concluya orando juntos para que seamos una familia que se ayuda mutuamente a crecer en la fe.

**ORAR JUNTOS**

el salmo de hoy, el Salmo 19 o el Padre Nuestro.

**"Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward." (Mark 9:41)**

We are made in God's image and likeness. We tend to forget this. When you look at others, do you see the face of Jesus in them? When others look at you, do they see the face of Jesus in you? When we realize that all lives matter to God, then gratitude and generously become easier. Why? Because that's the way we are made! We are one Body of Christ; when one of us is hurting, all of us feel the pain.

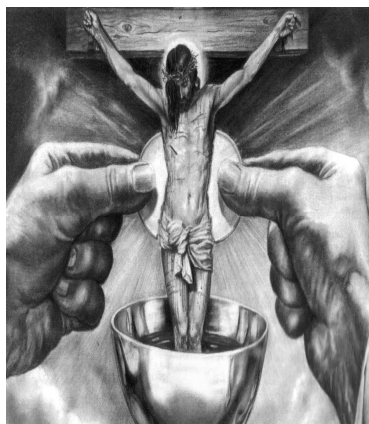
