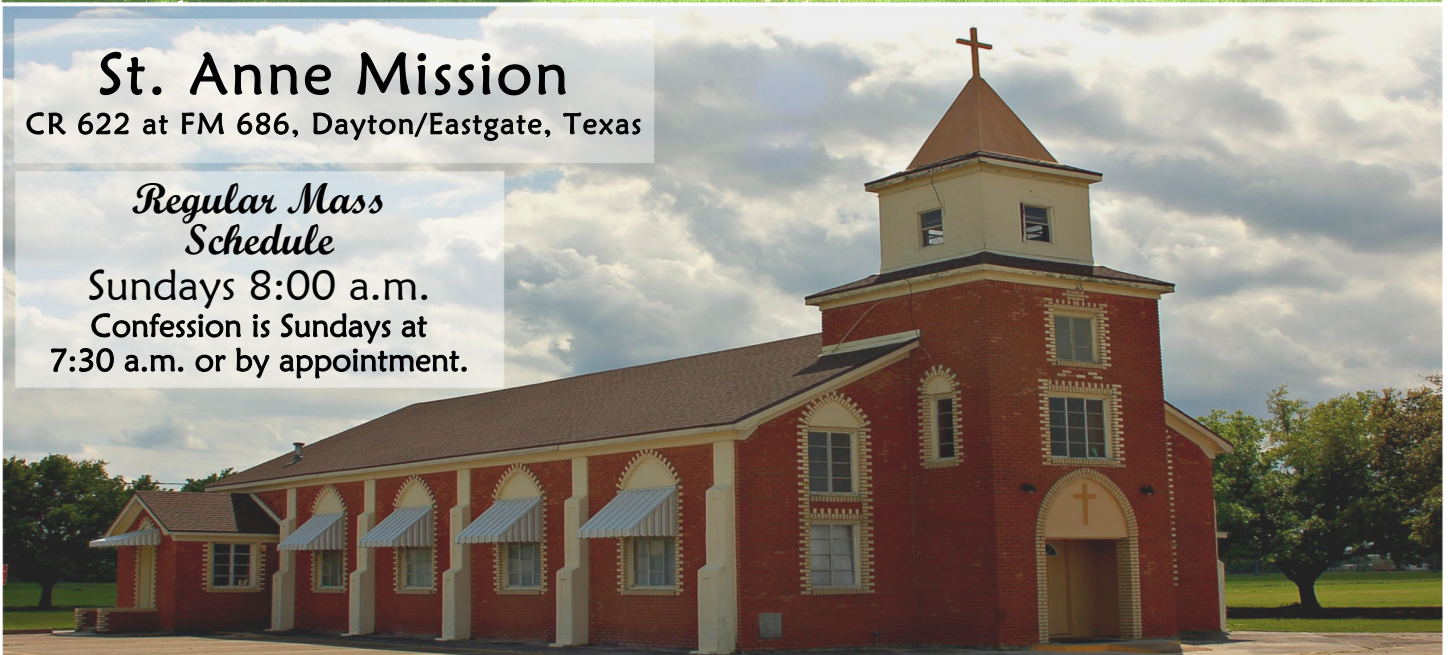

**Thirty Second Sunday in Ordinary Time,  
Year C  
Luke 20:27-38**

In the Gospel this week, Jesus tells us that after we die, we will not need the same things we did when we were alive, but we will continue to have a relationship with God. You could use the example of a tree to help your children understand what Jesus tells us. When a tree is alive it needs water, soil, and sunlight. When the tree is used to make a table, a toy, or something else it has a new purpose. The tree no longer needs water, soil, or sunlight. Tell your children about your hope and faith in the resurrection of the body and eternal life with God.

**READ TOGETHER**

Read together the short form of the Gospel, Luke 20:27, 34-38.

**TALK TOGETHER**

Children in our culture often know very little about death, dying, and eternal life. Take this opportunity to talk with your children about their thoughts, beliefs, maybe even their fears, about death and dying.

**PRAY TOGETHER**

Pray together for those in your family who have died and conclude by praying today's Psalm.

Lucas 20:27-38**

En el Evangelio de esta semana, Jesús nos dice que después de morir, no necesitaremos las mismas cosas que teníamos cuando estábamos vivos, pero continuaremos teniendo una relación con Dios. Podría usar el ejemplo de un árbol para ayudar a sus hijos a entender lo que Jesús nos dice. Cuando un árbol está vivo, necesita agua, tierra y luz solar. Cuando el árbol se usa para hacer una mesa, un juguete o cualquier otra cosa, tiene un nuevo propósito. El árbol ya no necesita agua, tierra o luz solar. Cuéntales a tus hijos sobre tu esperanza y fe en la resurrección del cuerpo y la vida eterna con Dios.

**LEER JUNTOS**

Lean juntos la forma abreviada del Evangelio, Lucas 20:27, 34-38.

**HABLEN JUNTOS**

Los niños en nuestra cultura a menudo saben muy poco acerca de la muerte, el morir y la vida eterna. Aproveche esta oportunidad para hablar con sus hijos sobre sus pensamientos, creencias, tal vez incluso sus miedos, sobre la muerte y el morir.

**OREN JUNTOS**

Oren juntos por aquellos en su familia que han muerto y concluyan rezando el Salmo de hoy.

*"May our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting encouragement and good hope through his grace, encourage your hearts and strengthen them in every good deed and word." 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17*

There are two important lessons here. First, we are called to be generous with our encouragement and hope with others. As God shows us mercy, we must be merciful to others. Second, joy is contagious! The joy we receive from doing good works not only strengthens us, it encourages others as well. Share the joy of living your faith whenever you can.

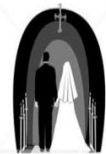
ORDEN DE INICIACIÓN CRISTIANA PARA ADULTOS (RICA)

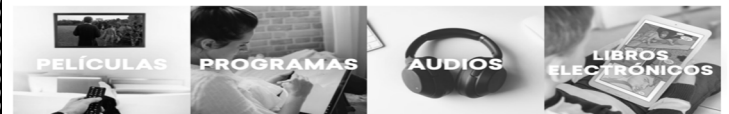
