**Fifth Sunday of Lent,
Year A
John 11:1-45**

Jesus' promise of eternal life is a central element of our Catholic faith. Even though Easter is still two weeks away, our Gospel today invites us to acknowledge Jesus' power over death, evidenced in the raising of Lazarus, and to anticipate Jesus' conquering of death once and for all in his death and Resurrection. We sometimes use examples from nature to help describe this mystery of our faith. Jesus himself talked about the seed that dies when planted in the ground in order to produce new life (John 12:24). Using that image and others, we find hope and confidence in Jesus, the Resurrection and the life.

TALK TOGETHER

Gather your family today and write Jesus' promise from today's Gospel ("I am the resurrection and the life.") on a large sheet of white paper. As your family talks about what Jesus means by this promise, decorate Jesus' words with symbols that will remind you of his promise of eternal life. Display this reminder of Jesus' promise in a prominent place in your home and keep it there until Easter.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, John 11:1-45.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray that you will always remain confident in Jesus' promise of eternal life. Conclude by praying together the Apostles' Creed or the Nicene Creed.

Juan 11:1-45**

La promesa de Jesús de la vida eterna es un elemento central de nuestra fe católica. Aunque la Pascua aún está a dos semanas de distancia, nuestro Evangelio de hoy nos invita a reconocer el poder de Jesús sobre la muerte, evidenciado en la resurrección de Lázaro, y a anticipar la conquista de la muerte por parte de Jesús de una vez por todas en su muerte y Resurrección. A veces usamos ejemplos de la naturaleza para ayudar a describir este misterio de nuestra fe. El mismo Jesús habló sobre la semilla que muere al ser plantada en la tierra para producir nueva vida (Juan 12:24). Usando esa imagen y otras, encontramos esperanza y confianza en Jesús, la Resurrección y la vida.

LEER JUNTOS

Reúne a tu familia hoy y escribe la promesa de Jesús del Evangelio de hoy ("Yo soy la resurrección y la vida.") en una hoja grande de papel blanco. Mientras tu familia habla sobre lo que Jesús significa con esta promesa, decora las palabras de Jesús con símbolos que te recuerden su promesa de vida eterna. Muestra este recordatorio de la promesa de Jesús en un lugar destacado de tu hogar y mantenlo allí hasta la Pascua.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Juan 11:1-45.

Ora para que siempre permanezcas confiado en la promesa de vida eterna de Jesús. Concluyan rezando juntos el Credo de los Apóstoles o el Credo Niceno.


