Twenty Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ Year A
Matthew 21:28-32

The example Jesus poses in today's Gospel could have been taken directly from family experience. Each of us can recall instances in which family members spoke one thing but then did another. The point of Jesus' story is to show that our actions speak louder than words, even with God.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, talk about times when a family member said one thing and then did another. Acknowledge that sometimes the action taken displays a true change of heart. Then Observe that Jesus faulted the religious leaders for not allowing John the Baptist's message of repentance to change their hearts and actions. The word we sometimes use for this change of heart is conversion. Jesus wants us to do more than pay lip service to the Gospel; he wants us to be transformed by his word.

READ TOGETHER

Read together this Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 21:28-32.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together that your family will experience a conversion to God and show evidence of this in both actions and words. Pray together today's second reading, Philippians 2:1-5.



Pastor's Family Corner

Vigésimo Sexto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario ~ Año A
Mateo 21:28-32

El ejemplo que Jesús plantea en el Evangelio de hoy podría haberse tomado directamente de la experiencia familiar. Cada uno de nosotros puede recordar ocasiones en que los miembros de la familia decían una cosa pero luego hacían otra. El objetivo de la historia de Jesús es mostrar que nuestras acciones hablan más fuerte que las palabras, incluso con Dios.

HABLEN JUNTOS

Mientras se reúnen en familia, hablen sobre momentos en los que un miembro de la familia dijo una cosa y luego hizo otra. Reconozcan que a veces la acción refleja un verdadero cambio de corazón. Luego observen que Jesús reprendió a los líderes religiosos por no permitir que el mensaje de arrepentimiento de Juan el Bautista cambiara sus corazones y acciones. La palabra que a veces usamos para este cambio de corazón es conversión. Jesús quiere que hagamos más que solo palabras del Evangelio; quiere que seamos transformados por su palabra.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos con su familia el Evangelio de este domingo, Mateo 21:28-32.

OREN JUNTOS

Recen juntos para que su familia experimente una conversión a Dios y muestre evidencia de esto tanto en acciones como en palabras. Recen juntos la segunda lectura de hoy, Filipenses 2:1-5.

"Do nothing out of selfishness; rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves..."

Philippians 2:3

Pride and ego are hard things to control. We see how others act or dress and think we are superior to them. We idolize our own self-image. But, if we truly believe everything is a gift from God, we recognize all the people that God has put in our lives as gifts! We are grateful for how they enrich our lives. Pray every day for the people in your life: your family, your friends and those who make you angry.

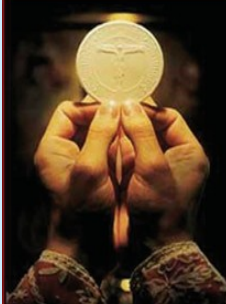

Amen.



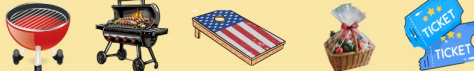

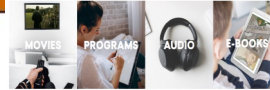
