**Fifth Sunday In Ordinary,
Year A
Matthew 5:13-16**

The widespread use of electricity in our society may make us less aware of the value and importance of light. To re-engage with the power of the metaphor that Jesus offers, gather your family in a darkened room. Bring only one flashlight.

TALK TOGETHER

Sit together for a minute and consider what you are able to do and see in so little light. You might try opening the Bible to see whether you can read today's Gospel. Turn on the flashlight and experiment to see how one might use it to achieve the greatest amount of light. Then read today's Gospel by the light of the flashlight. Ask everyone to consider what it means to say that Christians are to be the light of the world. How might your family act in a way that is a light for others, a light that is worthy to put on a lamp stand? Choose one thing that your family will do this week to show that you are the light of the world. You might choose to participate in an activity that your parish sponsors, such as help with a food pantry.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, Matthew 5:13-16.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together by singing "This Little Light of Mine."

Enciendan la linterna y experimenten para ver cómo se puede usar para lograr la mayor cantidad de luz posible. Luego, lean el Evangelio de hoy a la luz de la linterna. Pidan a todos que consideren lo que significa decir que los cristianos deben ser la luz del mundo. ¿Cómo podría actuar su familia de manera que sea una luz para los demás, una luz digna de ponerse en un candelero? Elijan una cosa que su familia hará esta semana para mostrar que son la luz del mundo. Pueden elegir participar en una actividad patrocinada por su parroquia, como ayudar en una despensa de alimentos.

Wednesday, February 11th is the Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, commemorating the 18 apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Saint Bernadette which occurred between February 11th and July 16th of 1858 near the town of Lourdes in the Hautes-Pyrenees region of France. Though there would be other people with her, only Saint Bernadette could see Our Lady.

During the 9th appearance, on February 25th, Our Lady told Bernadette to drink from a spring that suddenly appeared in the grotto where the apparitions occurred. During the 12th appearance, on March 1st, a visitor washed her arm in water from the spring, and some nerve damage in it was immediately cured. There is a tradition of miraculous cures at the grotto, or received by those who drink or are bathed in its waters.

Bernadette later said that she believed the water had no special properties, but that it helped focus the faithful who received the cures through faith and prayer. During the 13th appearance, on March 2nd, Our Lady told Bernadette to tell local priests that they should build a chapel at the grotto, and have processions to be made to it. The priests were understandably skeptical, but due to the numbers of pilgrims coming to the area, construction of several churches was started within a few years. During the 16th appearance, on March 25th, Our Lady identified herself as "The Immaculate Conception". Millions of people make a pilgrimage to this holy site every year and many miracles have been reported to have occurred there.

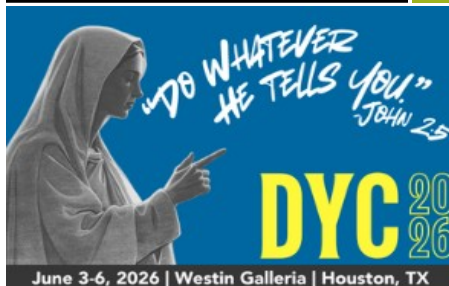

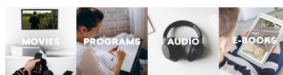

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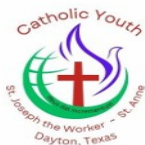
