**Twenty-Second Sunday
in Ordinary Time ~ Year A
Matthew 16:21-27**

Peter was expecting a Messiah that would carry out a different plan than the one Jesus had explained. Jesus was indeed the Messiah, but his life and death would show a different understanding of what it means to be the Messiah. We too have expectations of God and our own ideas about what we think God ought to be doing in our world. Like Peter we may risk limiting our image of God by thinking only in human ways. God's plan is always more than we can ever imagine.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, talk about what we expect God to be doing in our world and in our family life. Why do you think Peter was so upset by what Jesus was saying? Notice how Jesus reprimands Peter. Do we sometimes forget to let God be God for us? That is, do we sometimes get discouraged because God doesn't act in our world in the ways that we expect? Pray together that your family will remember that God is always working for the world's salvation in ways that are beyond our human imaginings.

READ TOGETHER

Read together this Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 16:21-27 with your family.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude by praying together today's Psalm, Psalm 63.

Mateo 16:21-27**

Pedro esperaba un Mesías que llevara a cabo un plan diferente al que Jesús había explicado. Jesús era de hecho el Mesías, pero su vida y muerte mostrarían una comprensión distinta de lo que significa ser el Mesías. Nosotros también tenemos expectativas de Dios y nuestras propias

ideas sobre lo que creemos que Dios debería estar haciendo en nuestro mundo. Como Pedro, podemos arriesgarnos a limitar nuestra imagen de Dios pensando solo de manera humana. El plan de Dios siempre es más de lo que jamás podríamos imaginar.

HABLEN JUNTOS

Mientras se reúnen como familia, hablen sobre lo que esperamos que Dios esté haciendo en nuestro mundo y en la vida de nuestra familia. ¿Por qué creen que Pedro se molestó tanto por lo que Jesús estaba diciendo? Noten cómo Jesús reprende a Pedro. ¿A veces olvidamos dejar que Dios sea Dios para nosotros? Es decir, ¿a veces nos desanimamos porque Dios no actúa en nuestro mundo de la manera que esperamos? Recen juntos para que su familia recuerde que Dios siempre está trabajando por la salvación del mundo de maneras que van más allá de nuestra imaginación humana.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos con su familia el Evangelio de este domingo, Mateo 16:21-27.

OREN JUNTOS

Concluyan rezando juntos el Salmo de hoy, el Salmo 62.

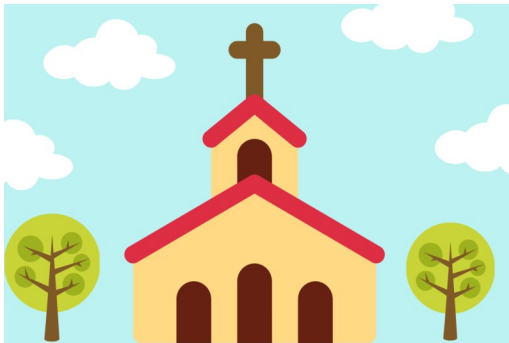

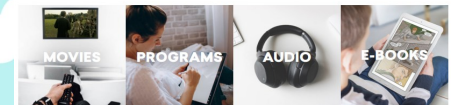

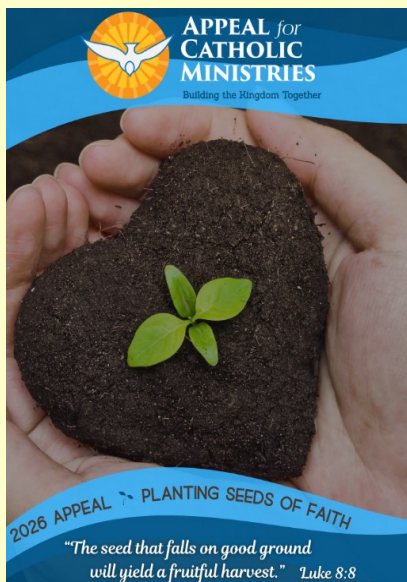
