The Ascension of The Lord, Year C Luke 24:46-53

Any family that has tried to sit down to a family dinner or packed the car for a trip has heard children argue at least once about who should sit where. To sit next to someone, especially if that person is important, is to have a place of honor. Jesus has this place of honor, seated now at the right hand of the Father (as we say in the Nicene Creed and the Apostles' Creed), but there's more to this metaphor than where Jesus sits in relation to God. To be in the place of honor is also to be in a place of power. Knowing people in powerful places can be very helpful. Children remind us of this each time we are called upon to referee a conflict. Jesus, honored now at God's right hand, is a powerful ally for us.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, recall a time when there was a discussion, or perhaps even an argument, about where people were going to sit. Talk about why it might be important to a person to sit in a particular place. Mention that in this Sunday's Gospel we learn about Jesus' place in heaven. Talk about how in the Creed we describe Jesus' place in heaven as "seated at the right hand of the Father." Discuss what we might learn about the relationship between God and Jesus from today's Gospel and from the Creed and what we can learn about Jesus' relationship to us. Observe that one of the things we learn is that Jesus continues to help us from this place of honor in heaven.

READ TOGETHER

Read aloud today's Gospel, Luke 24:46-53.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together the Apostles' Creed.



Pastor's Family Corner

La Ascensión del Señor Año C Lucas 24:46-53

Cualquier familia que haya intentado sentarse a una cena familiar o empacar el coche para un viaje ha oído a los niños discutir al menos una vez sobre quién debería sentarse dónde. Sentarse al lado de alguien, especialmente si esa persona es importante, es tener un lugar de honor. Jesús tiene este lugar de honor, sentado ahora a la derecha del Padre (como decimos en el Credo Niceno y el Credo de los Apóstoles), pero hay más en esta metáfora que donde Jesús se sienta en relación con Dios. Estar en el lugar de honor también es estar en un lugar de poder. Conocer a personas en lugares poderosos puede ser muy útil. Los niños nos recuerdan esto cada vez que se nos llama para arbitrar un conflicto. Jesús, honrado ahora a la derecha de Dios, es un poderoso aliado para nosotros.

HABLEN JUNTOS

Mientras se reúnen como familia, recuerden un momento en el que hubo una discusión, o quizás incluso una pelea, sobre dónde se iban a sentar las personas. Hablen acerca de por qué podría ser importante para alguien sentarse en un lugar en particular. Mencionen que en el Evangelio de este domingo aprendemos sobre el lugar de Jesús en el cielo. Hablen sobre cómo en el Credo describimos el lugar de Jesús en el cielo como "sentado a la derecha del Padre." Discutan lo que podríamos aprender sobre la relación entre Dios y Jesús a partir del Evangelio de hoy y del Credo, y lo que podemos aprender sobre la relación de Jesús con nosotros. Observen que una de las cosas que aprendemos es que Jesús continúa ayudándonos desde este lugar de honor en el cielo.

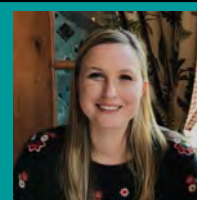

THE ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

The Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ is described in the above passage from the Acts of the Apostles, and is also noted in Mark 16:19 and Luke 24:50-53. Jesus refers to his Ascension in the Gospel of John when he tells Mary Magdalene, *"Stop holding on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father, but go to my brothers and say to them, I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God"*. Before his Ascension, Christ spent *forty days* teaching the Apostles and disciples about the Kingdom of God. The Lord informed them that they would receive power from the Holy Spirit to be his *witnesses* to the ends of the earth. The Ascension occurred at Bethany on the Mount of Olives. Christ's work of redemption has become known as the Paschal Mystery of Christ and was accomplished principally by his Passion, death, Resurrection, and Glorious Ascension into Heaven. The Paschal Mystery of Christ constitutes one action for the salvation of mankind, for Jesus "was handed over to death for our trespasses and was raised for our justification". Jesus Christ made multiple appearances in several locations to his disciples for forty days following his **Resurrection**. His final appearance in Scripture was to John on the island of Patmos in the Book of Revelation. His glorious Ascension signified the completion of his time on earth, which is celebrated by the Church forty days after the Resurrection and ten days before the Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit. Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us hope by promising that *"when I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also."*

Ascensión del Señor

La Ascensión de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo se describe en el pasaje anterior de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, y también se menciona en Marcos 16:19 y Lucas 24:50-53. Jesús se refiere a su Ascensión en el Evangelio de Juan cuando le dice a María Magdalena: *"No me retengas, porque todavía no he subido al Padre. Ve a decir a mis hermanos: 'Subo a mi Padre, el Padre de ustedes; a mi Dios, el Dios de ustedes'"*. Antes de su Ascensión, Cristo pasó cuarenta días enseñando a los Apóstoles y discípulos sobre el Reino de Dios. El Señor les informó que recibirían poder del Espíritu Santo para ser sus testigos hasta los confines de la tierra. La Ascensión ocurrió en Betania en el Monte de los Olivos. La obra de redención de Cristo ha llegado a ser conocida como el Misterio Pascual de Cristo y se cumplió principalmente mediante su Pasión, muerte, Resurrección y Ascensión Gloriosa al Cielo. El Misterio Pascual de Cristo constituye una acción para la salvación de la humanidad, porque Jesús "fue entregado a la muerte por nuestras transgresiones y resucitó para nuestra justificación". Jesucristo hizo múltiples apariciones en varios lugares a sus discípulos durante los cuarenta días posteriores a su **Resurrección**. Su última aparición en las Escrituras fue ante Juan en la isla de Patmos en el Libro del Apocalipsis. Su gloriosa Ascensión significó el cumplimiento de su tiempo en la tierra, que la Iglesia celebra cuarenta días después de la Resurrección y diez días antes del Pentecostés, la venida del Espíritu Santo. Nuestro Señor Jesucristo nos dio esperanza al prometer que *"Y cuando haya ido y os haya preparado un lugar, volveré y os tomaré conmigo, para que donde esté yo estéis también vosotros."*

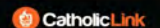
Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

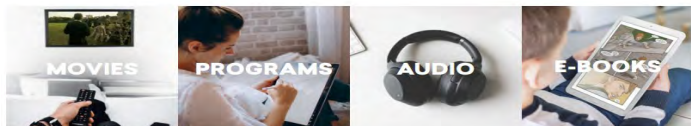

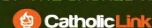

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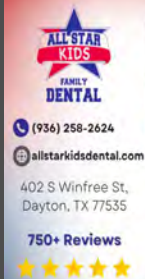
