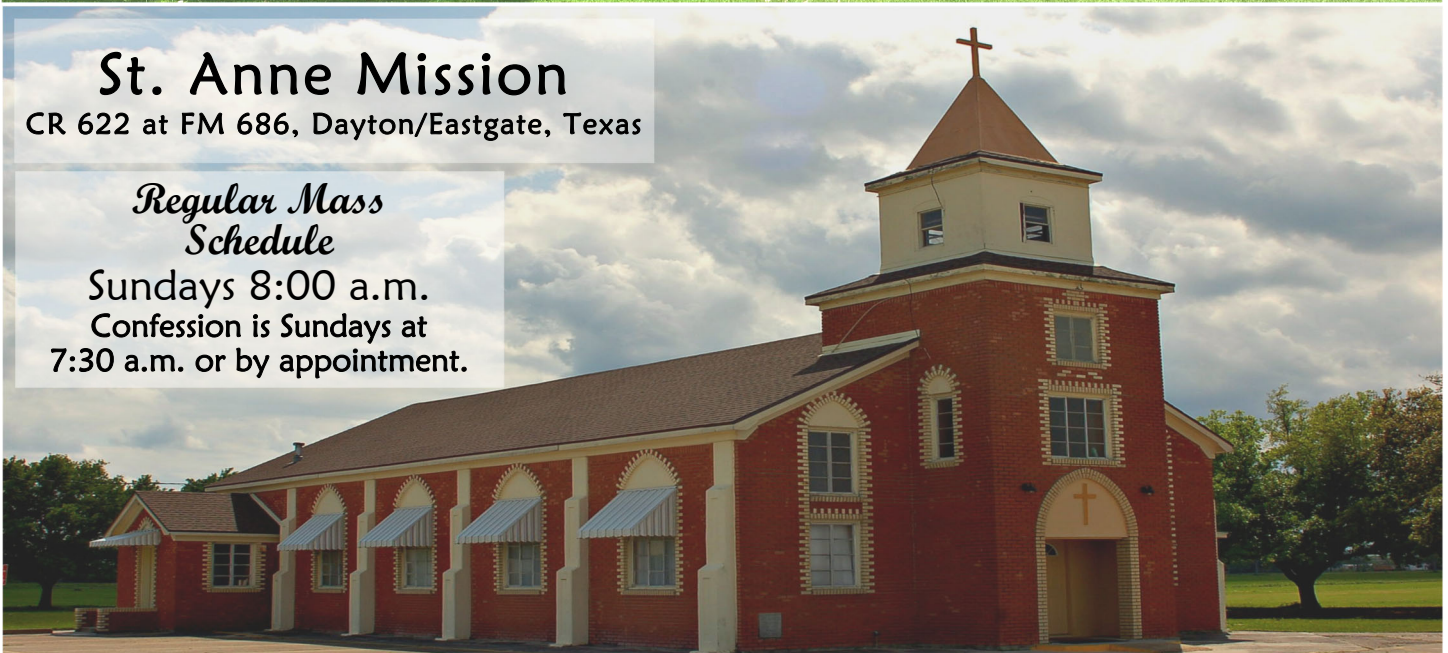

**Thirty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time,
Year C
Luke 21:5-19**

Children, while innocently naïve about most world events, are also profoundly sensitive to the concerns felt by adults. We can help children interpret adult concerns by sharing information about current events in appropriate ways. We can also put these concerns in the light of God's kingdom and the assurance of God's care for us. Notice how Jesus said that even when his disciples are persecuted, God would be with them.

READ TOGETHER

Today's Gospel, Luke 21:5-19.

TALK TOGETHER

Discuss with your children one or more current events or a situation in your family which shows difficulties that may challenge our trust in a God who cares for us. Talk about ways in which God might bring good out of the difficult events you discussed. Talk together about some actions you might take as a family to make better the situations you discussed.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude by praying for the needs of the people involved in the events you named. In prayer, place each of these difficult situations into God's hands.

Los niños, aunque inocentemente ingenuos acerca de la mayoría de los eventos mundiales, también son profundamente sensibles a las preocupaciones que sienten los adultos. Podemos ayudar a los niños a interpretar las preocupaciones de los adultos al compartir información sobre eventos actuales de manera apropiada. También podemos poner estas preocupaciones a la luz del reino de Dios y la seguridad del cuidado de Dios por nosotros. Note cómo Jesús dijo que aun cuando sus discípulos fueran perseguidos, Dios estaría con ellos.

LEER JUNTOS

El Evangelio, Lucas 21:5-19.

HABLEN JUNTOS

Hable con sus hijos sobre uno o más eventos actuales o una situación en su familia que muestre dificultades que puedan desafiar nuestra confianza en un Dios que se preocupa por nosotros. Hable acerca de las formas en que Dios podría sacar algo bueno de los eventos difíciles que hablaron. Hablen juntos sobre algunas acciones que podrían tomar como familia para mejorar las situaciones.

OREN JUNTOS

Concluya orando por las necesidades de las personas involucradas en los eventos que nombró. En oración, ponga cada una de estas situaciones difíciles en las manos de Dios.
