Third Sunday of Easter, Cycle C

John 21:1-19

Today's Gospel describes what we can easily imagine as a picnic on the beach. Just as Jesus' miracle at the wedding feast at Cana blesses the love between man and woman celebrated in the sacrament of marriage, Jesus' attentiveness to food and mealtimes raises the possibility that our meal gatherings can be sacred times. In families, the domestic church, our meals together are everyday opportunities to gather and recall Jesus' presence with us. As in the Eucharist, we bring the gifts that God has given us, which have been prepared especially for our Mass, and at our family meals we share gifts that God has given to us and that we have worked together to prepare. This includes the food on the table and also the people who gather around the table. We ask God to bless these gifts and to be present among us in all of our interactions.

READ TOGETHER

Today's Gospel, John 21:1-14.

TALK TOGETHER

Consider a recent family meal: What food was served? Where did the food come from? Who prepared the food? Who served the food? Was mealtime a happy time? Why or why not? Observe that today's Gospel tells about a meal that Jesus shared with his disciples after his Resurrection. Reflect on the Gospel reading using the questions above. Talk about ways in which this meal that Jesus shared with his disciples might remind us of the meal we share at the Eucharist. You might choose to plan a special meal together as a family, encouraging each person to participate in the meal preparation. Pray together that Jesus will make his loving presence known in your family life.

Juan 21:1-19

El Evangelio de hoy describe lo que podemos imaginar fácilmente como un picnic en la playa. Así como el milagro de Jesús en las bodas de Caná bendice el amor entre el hombre y la mujer celebrado en el sacramento del matrimonio, la atención de Jesús a la comida y las comidas plantea la posibilidad de que nuestras reuniones para comer puedan ser momentos sagrados. En las familias, la iglesia doméstica, nuestras comidas juntos son oportunidades cotidianas para reunirnos y recordar la presencia de Jesús con nosotros. Como en la Eucaristía, traemos los dones que Dios nos ha dado, que han sido preparados especialmente para nuestra Misa, y en nuestras comidas familiares compartimos los dones que Dios nos ha dado y que hemos trabajado juntos para preparar. Esto incluye la comida en la mesa y también las personas que se reúnen alrededor de la mesa. Pedimos a Dios que bendiga estos dones y que esté presente entre nosotros en todas nuestras interacciones.

LEER JUNTOS

Evangelio de hoy, Juan 21:1-14.

HABLE JUNTOS

Considere una comida familiar reciente: ¿Qué comida se sirvió? ¿De dónde vino la comida? ¿Quién preparó la comida? ¿Quién sirvió la comida? ¿Era la hora de comer un momento feliz? ¿Por qué o por qué no? Observe que el Evangelio de hoy habla de una comida que Jesús compartió con sus discípulos después de su Resurrección. Reflexione sobre la lectura del Evangelio utilizando las preguntas anteriores. Pense sobre las formas en que esta comida que Jesús compartió con sus discípulos podría recordarnos la comida que compartimos en la Eucaristía. Puede optar por planificar una comida especial en familia, animando a cada persona a participar en la preparación de la comida. Oren juntos para que Jesús haga notar su amorosa presencia en su vida familiar.

How often do you actually say the words "I love you" to Jesus, to family members, or to friends? We are made to be in relationship with God and each other. Sincerely telling someone that you love them is the best gift you can give them because it comes from your heart. You are giving them the gift of yourself. We all crave love. Tell someone you love them every day.

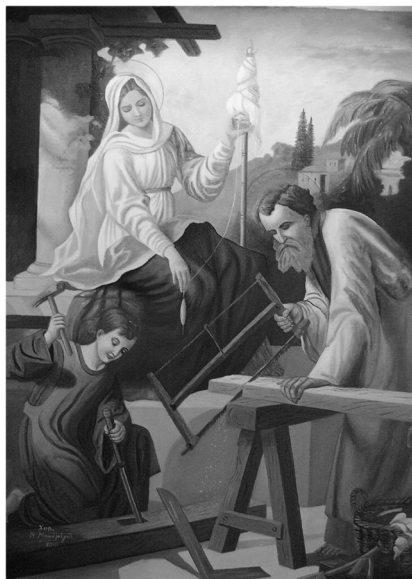

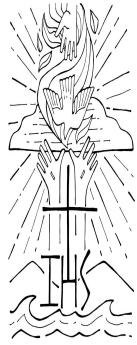
