The goal of our life of prayer is to increase our awareness that Jesus lives with us always. Prayer is more than a dialogue with God; prayer is a lifting of our minds and hearts to God so that God might dwell and act within us and through us. The pinnacle of our life of prayer is our communion with Jesus in the Eucharist. Through this sacrament, we receive Jesus himself, and he remains with us. Our life of prayer and our union with Jesus will lead us to fruitful service to others.

TALK TOGETHER

Place a plant in your gathering space. Invite everyone to look at the plant, noting the connection between the plant and its leaves. Talk about the integral connection between all the parts of a healthy plant. Introduce today's Gospel by saying that Jesus talked about his relationship to his disciples using this metaphor. Talk about the ways in which we are invited to relate to Jesus as his disciples today—prayer, Scripture, the Eucharist, and so on. When we do these things, Jesus promises to remain with us and to lead us to serve others well.

READ TOGETHER

Read together today's Gospel, John 15:1-8.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together that we will continue to be attentive and open to Jesus as he works in our lives today. Pray together the Acts of Faith, Hope, and Love.

Presente el Evangelio de hoy diciendo que Jesús habló de su relación con sus discípulos usando esta metáfora. Hable sobre las maneras en que estamos invitados a relacionarnos con Jesús como sus discípulos hoy: la oración, las Escrituras, la Eucaristía, etc. Cuando hacemos estas cosas, Jesús promete permanecer con nosotros y guiarnos a servir bien a los demás.

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Juan 15:1-8.

OREN JUNTOS

Oren juntos para que sigamos estando atentos y abiertos a Jesús mientras obra en nuestras vidas hoy. Recen juntos los Actos de Fe, Esperanza y Amor.

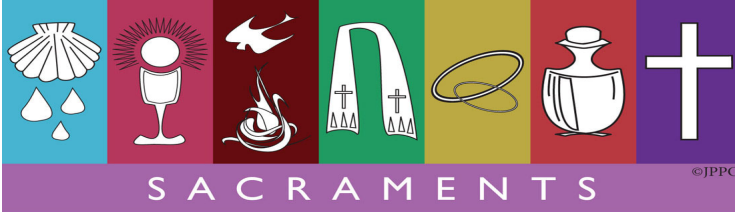

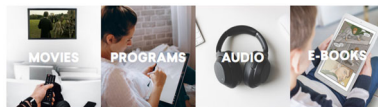
