



20th Sunday In Ordinary Time - Matthew 15:21-28


The story of the Canaanite woman who appealed to Jesus to cure her sickly daughter becomes an exciting one to learn. Questions such as the territorial boundary, religious practice, cultural norms, language, Jesus' mission to the gentiles, racial equality, love, and relationship between God and human beings all arise.

In the ancient Israel world, it becomes so rare for a woman to approach a foreign man with any business. Here, Jesus is crossing into the region of the gentiles who are not practicing the same culture and religion. On the one hand, their encounter reveals the love a mother has for her child. But on the other hand, it is the love of God toward all. The equality and justice that all people deserve of God's love and care; these rights require strong faith to the almighty God, who is above all other gods. The woman has demonstrated this qualification when she calls out to Jesus as Lord, Son of David. She demands her rights, saying, "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their master." She has gotten what she wanted, and her daughter was cured.

For God delivered all to disobedience, that he might have mercy upon all.

At that time, Jesus withdrew to the region of Tyre and Sidon. And behold, a Canaanite woman of that district came and called out, "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David! My daughter is tormented by a demon." But Jesus did not say a word in answer to her. Jesus' disciples came and asked him, "Send her away, for she keeps calling out after us." He said in reply, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." But the woman came and did Jesus homage, saying, "Lord, help me." He said in reply, "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs." She said, "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters." Then Jesus said to her in reply, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." And the woman's daughter was healed from that hour.

Pues, si su rechazo ha sido reconciliación para el mundo, ¿qué no será su reintegración, sino resurrección de entre los muertos? Porque Dios no se arrepiente de sus dones ni de su elección. Así como ustedes antes eran rebeldes contra Dios y ahora han alcanzado su misericordia con ocasión de la rebeldía de los judíos, en la misma forma, los judíos, que ahora son los rebeldes y que fueron la ocasión de que ustedes alcanzaran la misericordia de Dios, también ellos la alcanzarán. Evangelio**Mt 15, 21–28**

Mi hija está terriblemente atormentada por un demonio". Jesús no le contestó una sola palabra; pero los discípulos se acercaron y le rogaban: "Atiéndela, porque viene gritando detrás de nosotros". Él les contestó: "Yo no he sido enviado sino a las ovejas descarradas de la casa de Israel". Ella se acercó entonces a Jesús y postrada ante él, le dijo: "¡Señor, ayúdame!" SAINT OF THEDAY/ SANTO DEL DIA

Saturday, August 15 ~ Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary

The doctrine of the Assumption of Mary is recent: 1950. But the belief among the faithful that Mary was assumed body and soul into heaven at the time of her death dates to the early Church. Mary is also the summation of all Christians—what happened to her, will happen to us. Thus, she is the testimony of our own resurrection at the end of time.

Monday, August 17 ~ Saint Joan of the Cross

Transformed from greedy and surly businesswoman to saint is the story of Saint Joan of the Cross. Her conversion is credited to an elderly woman whom most people thought was crazy, but who reached Saint Joan's heart. Saint Joan of the Cross went on to found a religious congregation and several charitable institutions.

Tuesday, August 18 ~ Saint Louis of Toulouse

Born into royalty and headed for the throne of his father, Saint Louis of Toulouse renounced his status, became a Franciscan, and was named a bishop. It was during the years that he was held hostage and under the tutelage of the Friars, that Saint Louis began to realize his call to something other than the throne. He was known for his generosity to the poor.

Wednesday, August 19 ~ Saint Jane Frances de Chantal

Saint John Eudes was a noted preacher and confessor. He founded several seminaries because he saw the need for clerical formation. He also founded a couple of religious communities to address the needs that he saw. Saint John had a great devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Thursday, August 20 ~ Saint Bernard of Clairvaux

Wanting to be a simple monk in the quiet of a monastery, Saint Bernard of Clairvaux was called upon to be a very active member of the Church in his day. Preacher, reconciler, adviser, healer—just a few of the roles he was called to play. A man of many talents, he used his abilities for the service of the Church.

Friday, August 21 ~ Saint Pius X

A man of humble background, and wanting to maintain a simple lifestyle, Saint Pius X endured the trappings of the papacy as best he could. Known for encouraging frequent reception of Holy Communion, and concerned about world affairs, he led the Church in holiness and grace. He was undoubtedly one of the greatest popes of the 20th century.

Sábado, 15 de Agosto ~ Solemnidad de la Asunción de María

La doctrina de la Asunción de María es reciente: 1950. Lunes, 17 de Agosto ~ S. Juana de la Cruz

Transformada de mujer de negocios codiciosa y hosca en santa es la historia de Santa Juana de la Cruz. Su conversión se le atribuye a una anciana que la mayoría de la gente pensaba que estaba loca, pero que llegó al corazón de Santa Juana. Santa Juana de la Cruz fundó una congregación religiosa y varias instituciones benéficas..

Martes, 18 de Agosto ~ S. Clara de Asís

Nacido en la realeza y encaminado al trono de su padre, San Luis de Toulouse renunció a su estatus, se convirtió en franciscano y fue nombrado obispo. Fue durante los años que estuvo rehén y bajo la tutela de los frailes, que San Luis empezó a darse cuenta de su llamado a algo más que al trono. Era conocido por su generosidad con los pobres.

Miércoles, 19 de Agosto ~ S. Juan Eudes

Su gesto característico es la atención a los apóstoles. Corre el 1625 y Juan Eudes, normando, es un sacerdote que se dedica a la gente, especialmente si es pobre. Recorre la Francia embrutecida por la Guerra de los Treinta años. Funda la Congregación de Jesús y María, de quienes era muy devoto.

Jueves, 20 de Agosto ~ S. Bernardo

Doctor de la Iglesia, fundador de la abadía de Clairvaux (Claraval), uno de los padres de los cistercienses: San Bernardo de Claraval, cuya memoria litúrgica se celebra el 20 de agosto, recorrió los caminos de Europa, combatiendo herejías y defendiendo al Papa y a la Iglesia.

Viernes, 21 de Agosto ~ S. Pío X

Conocido por el Catecismo que lleva su nombre, el Papa Pío X, en el siglo Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto, gobernó la Iglesia desde 1903 hasta 1914, año en que falleció, un mes antes del estallido de la Primera Guerra Mundial. Canonizado por Pío XII en 1954, en la Iglesia se lo recuerda el 21 de agosto.
