**Fourth Sunday In Ordinary,
Year A
Matthew 5:1-12a**

Today's Gospel offers a contrast to many of the messages we hear in our society today. If we were to accept uncritically the "get ahead" messages of our culture, we would think that happiness means having money, being successful, having many possessions, and so on. When we think this way, we are not unlike the people who heard Jesus teach on the day that he taught the Beatitudes. The crowd that day also associated happiness with material possessions and status.

TALK TOGETHER

Talk as a family about what it means to be happy or to be blessed. Make a list of traits that you would associate with a happy person. Reflect on Jesus' description of happiness. Think about what each of the Beatitudes might have in common and write a family summary of the Beatitudes. Post the summary in a special place as a reminder of what your family will consider "true happiness."

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, Matthew 5:1-12a.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude by praying together prayers of petition based on the Beatitudes, e.g., "We pray that we will be peacemakers who seek to get along with other people even when this is difficult. We pray to the Lord." All respond: "Lord, hear our prayer."

**Cuarto Domingo En El Tiempo Ordinario, Año A
Mateo 5:1-12a**

El Evangelio de hoy ofrece un contraste con muchos de los mensajes que escuchamos en nuestra sociedad hoy en día. Si aceptáramos sin crítica los mensajes de "progresar" de nuestra

cultura, pensaríamos que la felicidad significa tener dinero, ser exitoso, tener muchas posesiones, y así sucesivamente. Cuando pensamos de esta manera, no somos diferentes de las personas que escucharon a Jesús enseñar el día que enseñó las Bienaventuranzas. La multitud ese día también asociaba la felicidad con las posesiones materiales y el estatus.

LEER JUNTOS

Hablen en familia sobre lo que significa ser feliz o estar bendecido. Hagan una lista de características que asociarían con una persona feliz. Reflexionen sobre la descripción de la felicidad según Jesús. Piensen en lo que cada una de las Bienaventuranzas podría tener en común y escriban un resumen familiar de las Bienaventuranzas. Colguen el resumen en un lugar especial como recordatorio de lo que su familia considerará la "verdadera felicidad".

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Mateo 5:1-12a.

OREN JUNTOS

Concluyan rezando juntos oraciones de petición basadas en las Bienaventuranzas, por ejemplo: "Oremos para que seamos hacedores de paz que busquen llevarse bien con los demás incluso cuando sea difícil. Oremos al Señor." Todos responden: "Señor, escucha nuestra oración."

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

MATTHEW 5:3

The phrase "poor in spirit" can be confusing. Think of it in this sense – poor in spirit means depending on God's providence and not depending on our own self-reliance. Being detached from earthly things (power, money, and comfort) and being attached to heavenly things (charity, sacrifice, and mercy). Denying ourselves from satisfying our desires and helping others obtain their basic needs.

La frase "pobres de espíritu" puede confundirnos. Piense de ella en este sentido - pobres de espíritu significa depender de la providencia de Dios y no de nuestra propia autosuficiencia. Desprendernos de las cosas terrenales (poder, dinero, y comodidad) y apegarnos a las cosas celestiales (caridad, sacrificio y misericordia). Negarnos a nosotros mismos la satisfacción de nuestros deseos y ayudar a otros a cubrir sus necesidades básicas.

FEBRUARY 2

Luke 2:22–40 Simeon recognizes the infant Jesus as the promised Messiah.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Because Simeon and Anna lived lives of prayer and fasting in the Temple, they were filled with the Spirit of God. That is why they were able to identify Jesus as the Savior even though Jesus was only a baby. To these two holy people, he was recognizable as the Redeemer who had been promised. Simeon described Jesus as “a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel.”

We too are called to recognize Jesus as Lord. Together as a family discuss ways to recognize Jesus as Lord by praying and attending Mass, fasting, and serving others. As a family, decide on one specific sacrifice you can make in order to alleviate the suffering or need of someone you know.

Simeón describió a Jesús como “luz para revelación a los gentiles y gloria para tu pueblo Israel”.

Juntos como familia hablen sobre diferentes maneras de reconocer a Jesús como Señor orando y asistiendo a Misa, ayunando y sirviendo a los demás. 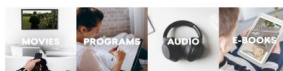
