Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ Year A Matthew 14:13-21

In our family life we can sometimes hear echoes of the disciples' excuses: "Five loaves and two fish are all we have here." Sometimes this echo is heard from children squabbling about the last piece of cake. Sometimes it is heard in our concern about the limits of the family's income or possessions. Sometimes this echo is heard in our complaints about the seemingly endless demands for our time and attention. Jesus understood these feelings and taught us to see beyond our limitations. Jesus modeled for us a compassion that reaches out to others, even when we would rather withdraw into ourselves. Jesus taught us that God blesses compassion offered to others with his grace. Today's Gospel reminds us that with God there is not only enough, there is an abundance!

TALK TOGETHER

Talk together about some of the stresses and demands for time and attention that your family members might feel. Acknowledge that we sometimes have to make difficult choices about how to use our time, talents, and treasure. Notice how much Jesus cared for the crowds, healing the sick even though he wanted to withdraw to a quiet place. Notice how the disciples responded to Jesus' instruction to feed the crowd; they noted their limited supply of food. Jesus blessed this limited supply of food, and it was enough to feed the entire crowd, more than 5,000 people, and there were leftovers! Pray together that Jesus will grant us compassion like his so that we will offer whatever we have to others with compassion and generosity.

READ TOGETHER

Read together this Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 14:13-21 with your family.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together today's Psalm, Psalm 145, or the Lord's Prayer.



Pastor's Family Corner

Decimotavo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario ~ Año A Mateo 14:13-21

En nuestra vida familiar a veces podemos escuchar ecos de las excusas de los discípulos: "Cinco panes y dos peces son todo lo que tenemos aquí." A veces este eco se escucha en los niños peleando por el último pedazo de pastel. A veces lo escuchamos en nuestra preocupación por los límites de los ingresos o posesiones de la familia. A veces se oye en nuestras quejas sobre las demandas aparentemente interminables de nuestro tiempo y atención. Jesús entendía estos sentimientos y nos enseñó a ver más allá de nuestras limitaciones. Jesús nos mostró una compasión que se extiende a los demás, incluso cuando preferiríamos encerrarnos en nosotros mismos. Jesús enseñó que Dios bendice la compasión ofrecida a los demás con su gracia. ¡El Evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que con Dios no solo hay suficiente, sino abundancia!

HABLEN JUNTOS

Hablen juntos sobre algunas de las presiones y demandas de tiempo y atención que los miembros de tu familia podrían sentir. Reconozcan que a veces tenemos que tomar decisiones difíciles sobre cómo usar nuestro tiempo, talentos y tesoros. Fíjense en cuánto se preocupaba Jesús por la multitud, sanando a los enfermos aunque quisiera retirarse a un lugar tranquilo. Observen cómo respondieron los discípulos a la instrucción de Jesús de alimentar a la multitud; notaron que tenían una cantidad limitada de comida. Jesús bendijo esta cantidad limitada de comida, y fue suficiente para alimentar a toda la multitud, ¡más de 5,000 personas, y aún sobraron! Recen juntos para que Jesús nos conceda compasión como la suya, para que ofrezcamos lo que tengamos a los demás con compasión y generosidad.

LEER JUNTOS

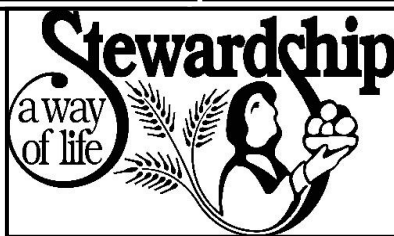
Lean juntos con tu familia el Evangelio de este domingo, Mateo 14:13-21.

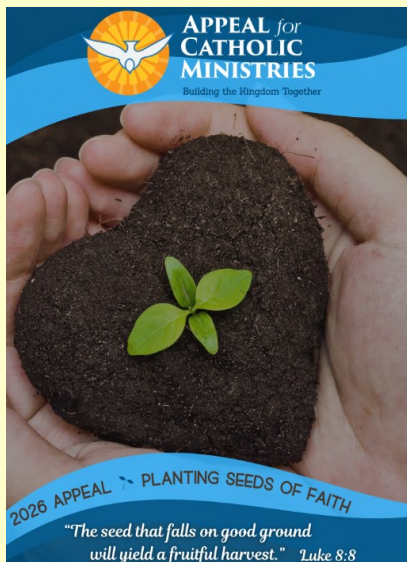
