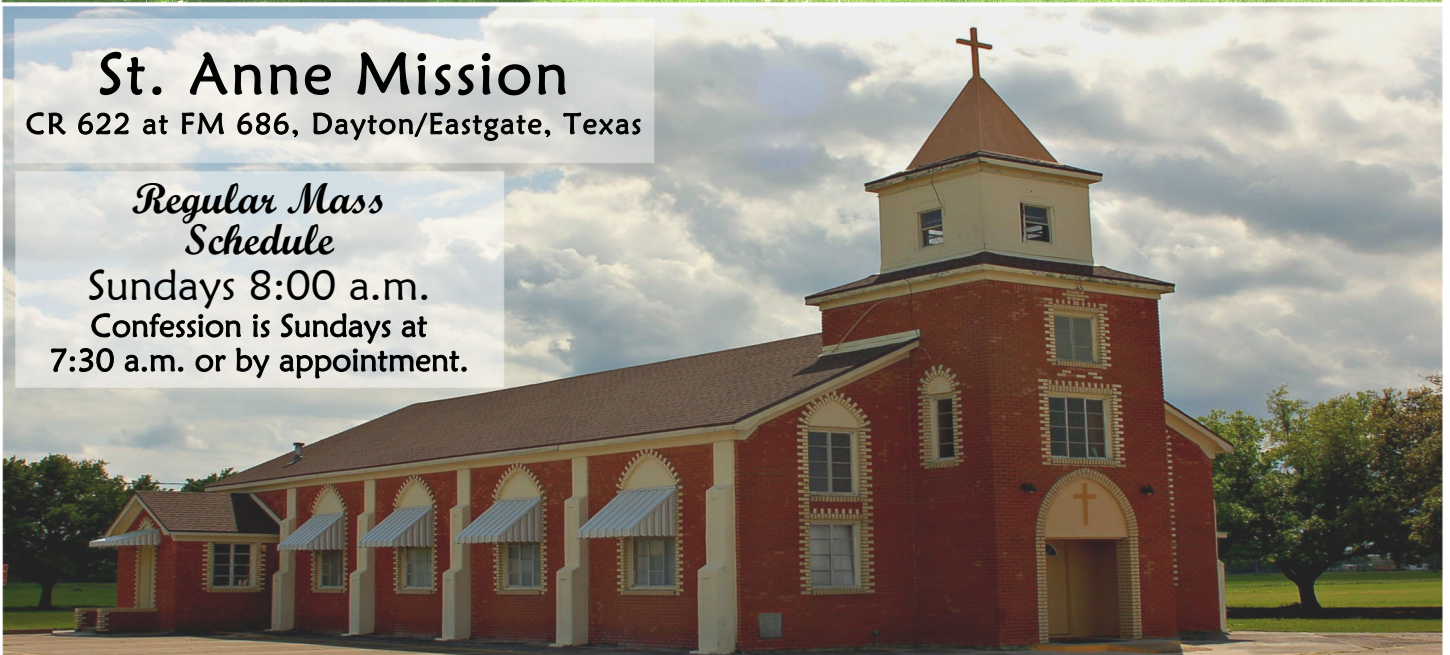

**Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time,

Luke 10:1-12,17-20

Families teach a sense of togetherness and community. It is in the family that we learn that we are dependent on one another and where we learn to work together and live together. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus sends out the 72 disciples in pairs, a sign that we are to work together to serve the mission of the Kingdom of God.

READ TOGETHER

Luke 10:1-12,17-20.

TALK TOGETHER

Talk about all the ways that your family works together. Talk about the various chores and tasks that family members work on together to accomplish in order to keep the household running smoothly. Talk about why it was important that Jesus sent his disciples out in pairs. Discuss ways that your family can work more closely together to support one another and to make the household run more smoothly. Pray for the strength to overcome the temptation to be too individualistic and to recognize the need for working together as a family.

Hable acerca de por qué era importante que Jesús enviara a sus discípulos en parejas. Discuta formas en que su familia puede trabajar juntos para apoyarse mutuamente y hacer que el hogar funcione sin problemas. Ore por la fuerza para vencer la tentación de ser demasiado individualista y para reconocer la necesidad de trabajar juntos.

As Catholics we are all called to serve. Each of us has been given "charisms" otherwise known as gifts from the Holy Spirit to help build God's Church. Our charisms can only be used for good. 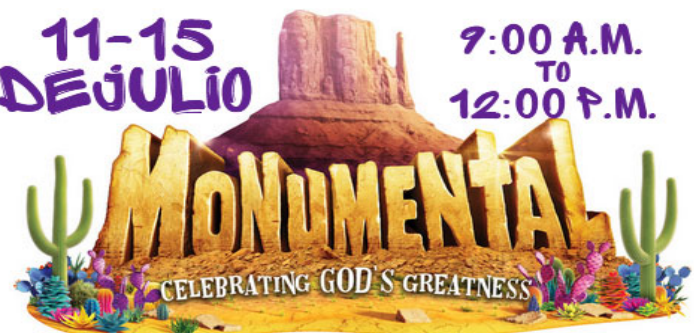

Month of the Precious Blood



Blood of Christ,
Eucharistic
drink and
refreshment of
souls, save us.

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood.

"The Precious Blood which we worship is the Blood which the Savior shed for us on Calvary and reassumed at His glorious Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses through the veins of His risen, glorified, living body at the right hand of God the Father in heaven; it is the Blood made present on our altars by the words of Consecration; it's the Blood which merited sanctifying grace for us and through it washes and beautifies our soul and inaugurates the beginning of eternal life in it."

Julio, mes de la Preciosísima Sangre de Cristo

El mes de julio está dedicado a la Preciosa Sangre. La fiesta de la Preciosa Sangre de Nuestro Señor fue instituida en 1849 por Pío IX, pero la devoción es tan antigua como el cristianismo. Los primeros Padres dicen que la Iglesia nació del costado traspasado de Cristo, y que los sacramentos fueron producidos a través de Su Sangre.

"La Preciosa Sangre que adoramos es la Sangre que el Salvador derramó por nosotros en el Calvario y reasumió en Su gloriosa Resurrección; es la Sangre que corre por las venas de Su cuerpo resucitado, glorificado, en cuerpo vivo y a la mano derecha de Dios Padre en el cielo; es la Sangre que se hace presente en nuestros altares por las palabras de la Consagración; es la Sangre que nos mereció la gracia santificante y por ella lava y embellece nuestra alma e inaugura en ella el comienzo de la vida eterna".
