## Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time,

Year C

Luke 15:1-32

Read or retell in your own words, the three stories from the Gospel. Ask your children to recall games they play that involve losing or hiding something and then finding it. (Hide and Go Seek, Ghost in the Graveyard, Button, Button, Who's Got the Button?) Talk about how exciting it is to find the person or thing being looked for.

### READ TOGETHER

Luke 15:1-32.

### TALK TOGETHER

Ask your children if they have any memories of losing something special or being lost themselves. Share the stories as well as the fears or feelings. Then tell them that just as you would go to any length to find and bring them home if they were lost, so too would God. That is what Jesus is telling us in the three stories. No matter what we do, no matter how wrong we are, God, our loving father, is always anxious to forgive us and welcome us back home.

Luego dígales que así como usted haría todo lo posible para encontrarlos y traerlos a casa si estuvieran perdidos, también lo haría Dios. Eso es lo que Jesús nos está diciendo en las tres historias. No importa lo que hagamos, no importa cuán equivocados estemos, Dios, nuestro padre amoroso, siempre está ansioso por perdonarnos y darnos la bienvenida de regreso a casa.



The Exaltation of the Holy Cross is commemorated by the Holy Catholic Church on September 14<sup>th</sup> and is a reminder of the importance of the core symbol of our faith as well as the sacrifice that Our Lord made upon the Holy Cross for our salvation. We honor that Cross on which Christ won for us our redemption. The Cross is the universal symbol of Christianity, and is a sign of victory over something that once was synonymous with a method of brutal torture. The Cross represents hope, salvation, freedom, and unconditional love. Our Lord loved us all so much, He chose to suffer a violent death on the Cross to save us all from the shackles of sin.

La Exaltación de la Santa Cruz es conmemorada por la Santa Iglesia Católica el 14 de septiembre y es un recordatorio de la importancia del símbolo central de nuestra fe, así como del sacrificio que Nuestro Señor hizo en la Santa Cruz para nuestra salvación. Honramos aquella Cruz en la que Cristo ganó para nosotros nuestra redención. La Cruz es el símbolo universal del cristianismo y es un signo de victoria sobre algo que alguna vez fue sinónimo de un método de tortura brutal. La Cruz representa la esperanza, la salvación, la libertad y el amor incondicional.
