Second Sunday of Lent
Year B
Mark 9:2-10

Every family has special moments that they remember and share again and again. In sharing these stories, the meaning and importance of these events develop and deepen over time. This is how it was with the disciples' remembrance of Jesus' Transfiguration. The full significance of what they had seen and experienced could only be understood after Jesus' death and Resurrection. As they told other believers about this event and recorded the story for us in the Bible, our understanding of what it means to call Jesus God's own Son has also deepened.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, think about some special family memories that your family tells over and over again. Talk about why these memories are important to you. Recall that in the Bible we find many important memories about Jesus that have been recorded for us so that we can believe that Jesus is God's Son.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, Mark 9:2-10. What do we learn about Jesus from this Gospel? (He fulfills the promises God made to Israel through the Law and the prophets. God glorified Jesus in his Resurrection. Jesus is God's Son.)

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude in prayer together that as we continue to read the Bible, we will deepen our understanding of and our love for Jesus. Pray together the Lord's Prayer.

Recuerde que en la Biblia encontramos muchos recuerdos importantes sobre Jesús que han sido registrados para que podamos creer que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean el evangelio de hoy, Marcos 9:2-10. ¿Qué aprendemos sobre Jesús en este Evangelio? (Él cumple las promesas que Dios hizo a Israel a través de la Ley y los profetas. Dios glorificó a Jesús en su Resurrección. Jesús es el Hijo de Dios.)

OREN JUNTOS

Concluyamos juntos en oración para que a medida que sigamos leyendo la Biblia, profundicemos nuestra comprensión y nuestro amor por Jesús. Oren juntos el Padrenuestro.

Anointing of the sick and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

Friday, March 1st 8:15 a.m. Mass.

Anointing of the Sick during Mass. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament following Mass for one hour. Come and spend some quiet time with Christ, truly and substantially present in the Eucharist.

What is Eucharistic Adoration?

Simply put, Adoration is prayer. Adoration is worship of Jesus Christ, who is fully present under the appearance of bread at Mass and reserved in tabernacles in Catholic Churches and Chapels. At Adoration, Jesus comes to meet us in a unique way, face-to-face. Adoration is a time for us to pray, to listen, and to be in his presence.

Where did it come from?

After Christ instituted the Eucharist and celebrated the first Mass at the Last Supper, He took his disciples to the Mount of Olives and invited them to stay awake with him, praying there in vigil for what was to come. Christ gave to the disciples, and to all Christians, this pattern of prayer. Jesus' question to his disciples, "Could you not keep watch for one hour?" This is the same question he asks us today.

Eucharistic Adoration is that time set aside when the Eucharist is "exposed" (placed in a monstrance on the altar) so that the faithful may see, pray, and adore our Risen Lord, present under the appearance of simple bread. Jesus is just as present in the tabernacle as in the monstrance, but many believers find comfort and peace when they are able to pray while looking upon Jesus exposed in the monstrance.

Unción de los enfermos y Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento

Viernes, 1 de Marzo 8:15 a.m. Misa. Unción de los Enfermos durante la Misa. Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento después de la Misa durante una hora. Ven y pasa un tiempo tranquilo con Cristo, verdadera y sustancialmente presente en la Eucaristía.

¿Qué es la Adoración Eucarística?

La Adoración es oración. La adoración es el culto a Jesucristo, quien está plenamente presente bajo la apariencia de pan en la Misa y reservado en tabernáculos y capillas de las iglesias católicas. En la Adoración, Jesús viene a nuestro encuentro de una manera única, cara a cara. La adoración es un tiempo para orar, escuchar y estar en su presencia.

¿De dónde vino?

Después de que Cristo instituyó la Eucaristía y celebró la primera Misa en la Última Cena, llevó a sus discípulos al Monte de los Olivos y los invitó a permanecer despiertos con Él, orando allí en vigilia por lo que estaba por venir. Cristo dio a los discípulos y a todos los cristianos este modelo de oración. La pregunta de Jesús a sus discípulos: "¿No pudisteis velar ni una hora?" Ésta es la misma pregunta que nos hace hoy.

La Adoración Eucarística es ese tiempo reservado en el que la Eucaristía es "expuesta" (colocada en una custodia sobre el altar) para que los fieles puedan ver, orar y adorar a nuestro Señor Resucitado, presente bajo la apariencia de un simple pan. Jesús está tan presente en el tabernáculo como en la custodia, pero muchos creyentes encuentran consuelo y paz cuando pueden orar mientras miran a Jesús expuesto en la custodia.




