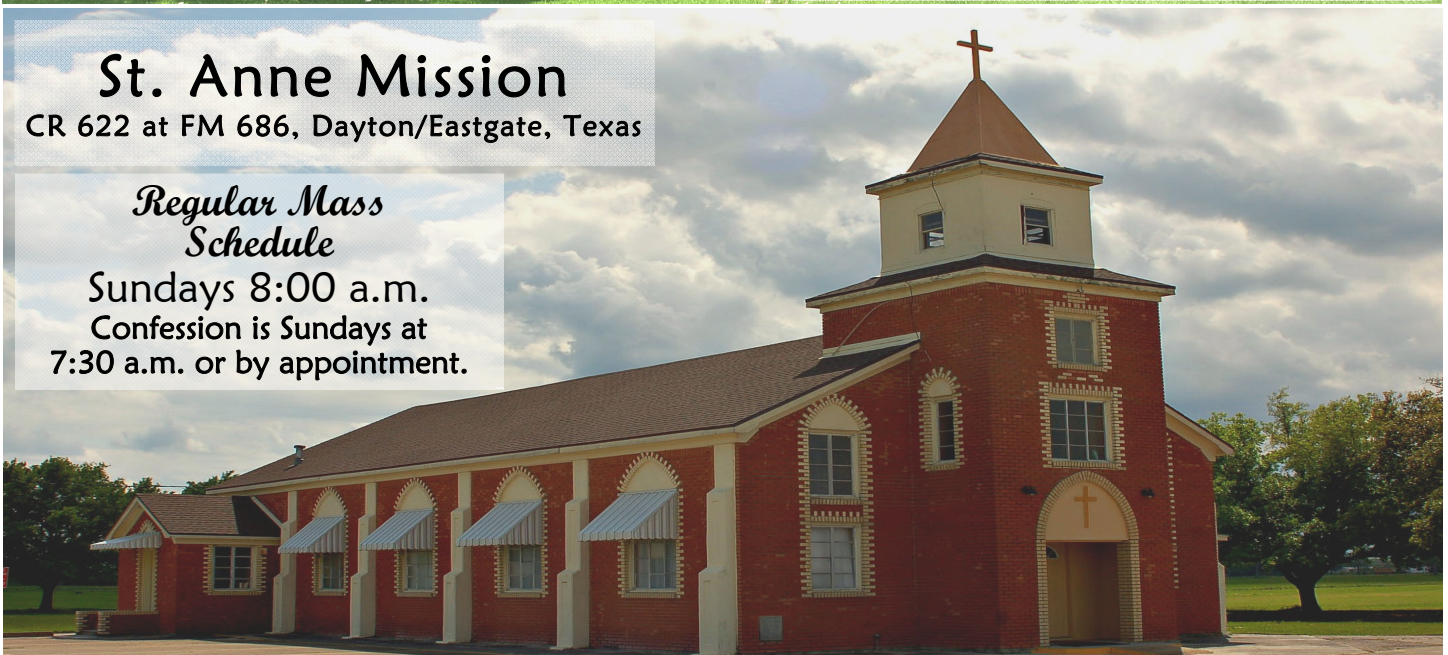

Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
Mark 10:2-16

Jesus' teaching about divorce and remarriage can be a challenging one for many people. The Church continues to uphold the strong and positive teaching of Jesus that God intends for a man and woman to make a lifelong commitment to one another in the Sacrament of Marriage. Many of us, however, know people whose marriage has not been a lifelong commitment. The example of Jesus teaches us that we are called to act with compassion and love in our relationships with all, and especially when people are hurting because of difficulties in their relationships. Most importantly, we remember that when marriages thrive, it is a sign of God's grace at work.

TALK TOGETHER

talk about what it means to make a promise or a commitment to someone. Offer examples of promises that are fairly easy to keep. Talk about examples of promises and commitments that might be more difficult to honor, like the marriage commitment that Jesus is asked about in this Gospel. Talk about how we need God to help us honor our commitment to love and care for each other. Jesus teaches that we should be like children before God, trusting God's promise to care for us and asking for his help to keep our commitments to love and care for others. Conclude by praying together that God will give his grace to us that we may honor our commitments to one another.

Más importante aún, recordamos que cuando los matrimonios prosperan, es una señal de la gracia de Dios en acción.

Hable sobre ejemplos de promesas y compromisos que podrían ser más difíciles de cumplir, como el compromiso matrimonial sobre el que se le pregunta a Jesús en este Evangelio. Hable sobre cómo necesitamos que Dios nos ayude a honrar nuestro compromiso de amarnos y cuidarnos unos a otros. Concluya orando juntos para que Dios nos dé su gracia para que podamos honrar nuestros compromisos que nos hacemos el uno al otro.

The creation story reminds us of two important points. First, since the start, God has put the entire world into our care. Second, stewardship has been around since the beginning of mankind, it isn't something recently invented by the Church. Just as past generations built our Church, it is now our responsibility to continue to nurture and develop these gifts for future generations.

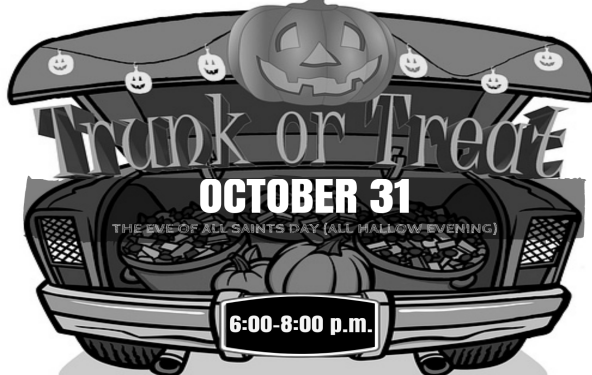
