Luke 24:13-35**

Families, as the domestic church, have the opportunity to make the family meal a time of prayerful encounter with one another and with Jesus. At a family meal we share our experiences of the day and connect them with the experiences of others in the family. We can also enjoy the meal as an opportunity to reflect upon our family life in light of Scripture. At their best our family meals can connect us to Jesus too.

**TALK TOGETHER**

Choose a family meal this week to share one another's experiences of the week in a special way. Perhaps invite family members to plan and prepare the meal together. Begin the meal by reading today's Gospel. As you eat, talk together about how the disciples discussed their experiences in Jerusalem and how they came to understand them differently when Jesus interpreted those events in the light of Scripture. Then invite each family member to share the things that are going on in his or her life. Consider what Jesus might say to each person if he were sitting at your dinner table. Conclude with a special prayer after your dinner. Pray a prayer of blessing for each family member, asking that Jesus continue to be present in each person's life, helping each one to be a better follower of Jesus. Conclude with a Sign of Peace.

**HABLEN JUNTOS**

Elijan una comida familiar esta semana para compartir las experiencias de cada uno de la semana de una manera especial. Tal vez inviten a los miembros de la familia a planear y preparar la comida juntos. Comiencen la comida leyendo el Evangelio de hoy. Mientras comen, hablen juntos sobre cómo los discípulos discutieron sus experiencias en Jerusalén y cómo llegaron a entenderlas de manera diferente cuando Jesús interpretó esos eventos a la luz de las Escrituras. Luego, inviten a cada miembro de la familia a compartir las cosas que están sucediendo en su vida. Consideren lo que Jesús podría decirle a cada persona si él estuviera sentado en su mesa. Concluyan con una oración especial después de la comida. Recen una oración de bendición por cada miembro de la familia, pidiendo que Jesús continúe presente en la vida de cada persona, ayudando a cada uno a ser un mejor seguidor de Jesús. Concluyan con un Signo de Paz.

How often do you take the time to discern what Jesus is calling you to do with your life? Are your prayers always petitions, asking Jesus to do things for you? If so, that's a one-sided relationship. Living our faith means developing a personal relationship with Jesus. Just like any friendship, there is give and take, each side listening to each other and helping each other out. Take time, in silence, to listen to what Jesus is asking of you today.

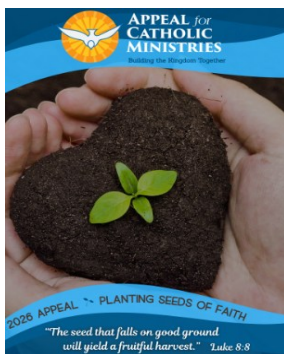
