Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time,
Year B
John 6:41-51

Today's Gospel focuses our attention on our faith in Jesus' presence in the Eucharist. Jesus is the bread of life. He gives us his Body and Blood as bread so that we may have eternal life. When we receive the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist, our lives begin to reflect the reality that our communion with Jesus prepares in us. Our Eucharist leads us to live as people of the promise, confident that we will one day share the fullness of life with God.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, talk about our hope that one day we will share eternal life with God in heaven. This hope can transform the way we live our daily lives, calling us to be people of hope and expectation. In today's Gospel, Jesus promises us this gift of eternal life in the Eucharist. Observe that Jesus taught us that those who listen to God know that Jesus has been sent by God for the life of the world. Jesus fulfills this promise to us through his passion, death, and Resurrection. He gives us the gift of himself in the Eucharist, which is his Body and Blood, given so that we may have eternal life.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, John 6:41-51.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude in prayer together asking God to increase our faith in Jesus' presence in the Eucharist. Pray together the Act of Faith.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús nos promete este don de la vida eterna en la Eucaristía. Observen que Jesús nos enseñó que quienes escuchan a Dios saben que Jesús ha sido enviado por Dios para la vida del mundo. Jesús cumple esta promesa que nos hizo a través de su pasión, muerte y resurrección. Él nos da el don de sí mismo en la Eucaristía, que es su Cuerpo y su Sangre, entregados para que podamos tener vida eterna.

Lean juntos en voz alta el Evangelio de Juan 6:41-51.

The Catholic Church dedicates August to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue.

Novena to the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

Most Blessed Mother, heart of love, heart of mercy, ever listening, caring, consoling, hear our prayer. As your children, we implore your intercession with Jesus your Son. Receive with understanding and compassion the petitions we place before you today, especially ... (special intentions).

Then pray 3 Hail Marys



La Iglesia Católica dedica agosto al Inmaculado Corazón de María. El corazón de María es venerado (y no adorado como el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús) porque está unido a su persona y es sede de su amor (especialmente por su divino Hijo), virtud y vida interior. Quinceañera

The young lady's family must be registered, participating members of the parish for at least 1 year. "Participating members" are those who faithfully attend Mass and support the Church financially (using their contribution envelopes proving such). Ideally, they should also be active in the ministry, volunteering in the Church.

The young lady must attend CCE classes faithfully for at least 1 YEAR PRIOR to the Quinceañera. She must have received the sacrament of Baptism and she must make her First Holy Communion BEFORE the Quinceañera. She must be faithfully attending Confirmation preparation classes. She, along with her Sponsor, must attend all Quinceañera preparation classes.

Please call office at least 1 YEAR BEFORE any other arrangements are made and DO NOT set a final date for the Quinceañera prior to your interview with the priest.

Quinceañera classes are held TWICE per year.

Los "miembros participantes" son aquellos que asisten fielmente a la Misa y apoyan económicamente a la Iglesia (utilizando sus sobres de contribución como prueba). Idealmente, también deberían ser activos en el ministerio, como voluntarios en la Iglesia.

La joven debe asistir fielmente a las clases de Catecismo durante al menos 1 AÑO ANTES de la Quinceañera. Ella debe haber recibido el sacramento del Bautismo y debe hacer su Primera Comunión ANTES de la Quinceañera. Ella debe asistir fielmente a las clases de preparación para la Confirmación. Ella, junto con su Patrocinador, debe asistir las clases de preparación para Quinceañera.

Por favor llame a la oficina al menos 1 AÑO ANTES de que se hagan otros arreglos y NO fije una fecha final para la Quinceañera antes de su entrevista con el sacerdote.

Las clases de quinceañera se llevan a cabo DOS VECES al año. La próxima fecha es:
