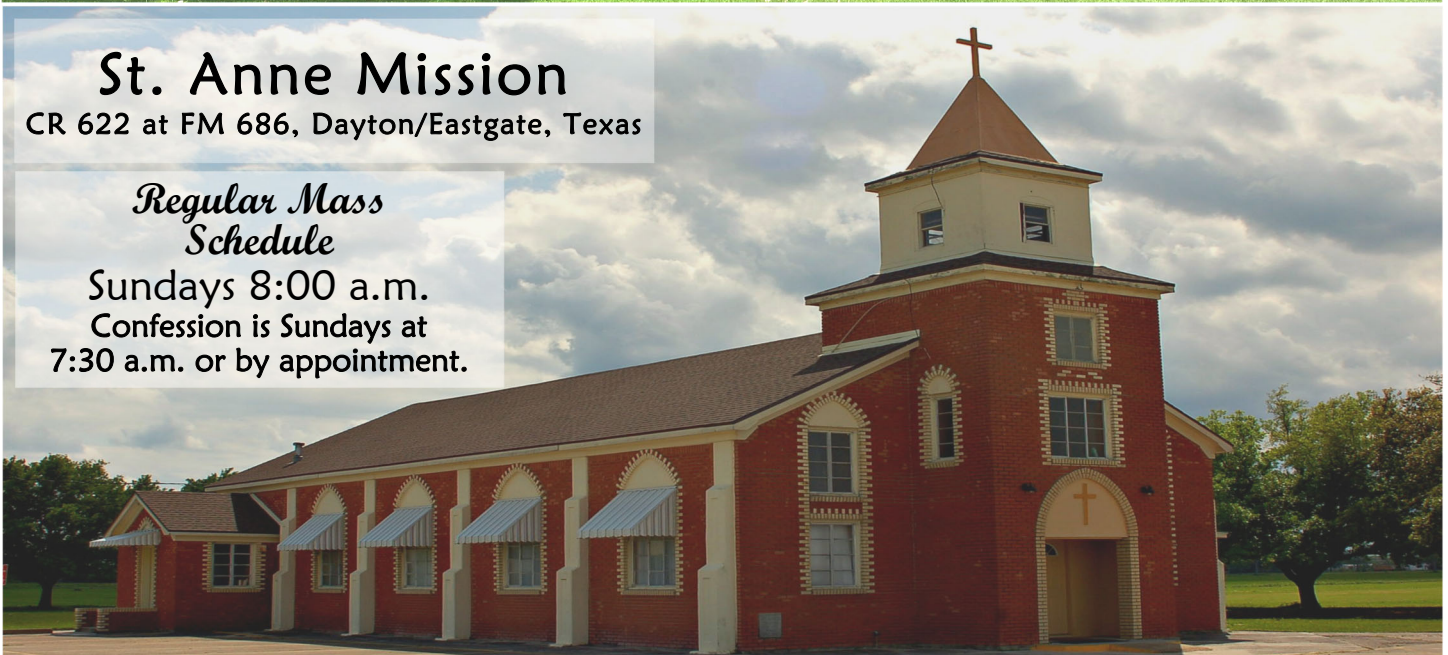

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Cycle C

Luke 9:11b-17

In our age of fast food and eating on the go, families often find that they are not eating meals together at a dinner table. As a family, look back over the past week and recall how many meals were eaten together and how many meals were eaten alone or on the run. In the Bible, meals are seen as much more than a means to satisfy a physical need. The Hebrew people viewed eating a meal as a way of expressing and strengthening their relationship to one another under God's covenant. It is no coincidence that meals are often the setting of Jesus' teaching and miracles in the Gospels. In this Sunday's Gospel, we hear the story of Jesus feeding the crowd of 5,000 people.

READ TOGETHER

Luke 9:11b-17.

TALK TOGETHER

Talk about the kinds of hungers that people have in addition to physical hunger. Describe the hungers that a family nourishes (love, compassion, forgiveness, laughter, and so on). Together give thanks for the food that Jesus gives us that we celebrate on this Sunday's feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus. Make a commitment to share in this Eucharistic meal together as a family.

En nuestra era de comida rápida y comida para llevar, las familias a menudo se dan cuenta de que no están comiendo juntos en una mesa. Como familia, revisen la semana pasada y recuerden cuántas comidas se comieron juntos y cuántas comidas se comieron solos o corriendo. En la Biblia, las comidas se consideran mucho más que un medio para satisfacer una necesidad física. El pueblo Hebreo veía comer una comida como una forma de expresar y fortalecer su relación mutua bajo el pacto de Dios. No es casualidad que las comidas sean a menudo el escenario de las enseñanzas y los milagros de Jesús en los Evangelios. En el Evangelio de este domingo, escuchamos la historia de Jesús alimentando a la multitud de 5,000 personas.

HABLE JUNTOS

Hable sobre los tipos de hambre que tiene la gente además del hambre física. Describir los hambres que alimenta una familia (amor, compasión, perdón, risa, etc.) Juntos demos gracias por el alimento que nos da Jesús que celebramos en la fiesta del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús de este domingo. Comprométanse a compartir esta comida eucarística juntos como familia.

It has been said that the best gift we can give someone is to teach them how to pray. If you don't talk and more importantly, listen, to God every day, how else will you know what He is calling you to do? Just as you talk to family and friends every day, get in the habit of talking with God every day. Develop a daily prayer routine. Keep your prayers simple and sincere. This is best done in silence, when you can hear His response.

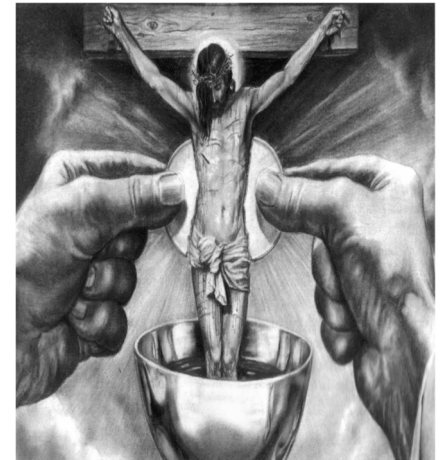

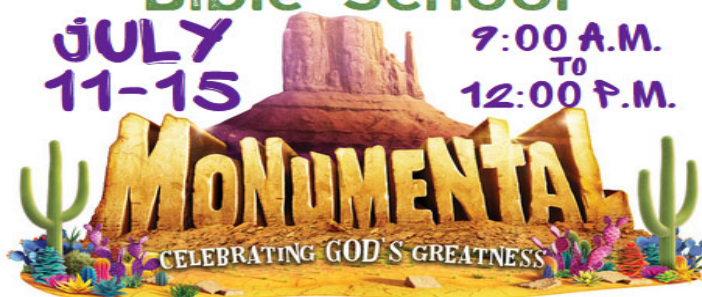
