**Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ Year A  
Matthew 10:37-42**

One can tell a lot about a family by the way they welcome others into their home. Despite parental efforts to elicit the best behavior from their children, family efforts to entertain guests are sometimes difficult. Practicing a spirit of Christian hospitality within the family can be an occasion to reflect upon the importance of this virtue. A family spirit of hospitality is a sign of faith.

**TALK TOGETHER**

When your family gathers, ask each person to consider the following questions about manners: What does it mean to be a good host? What does it mean to be a good guest? Invite each person to share their thoughts and experiences about being a guest or a host. Ask family members to describe what Jesus says about hospitality extended to his disciples. (Those who receive Jesus' disciples also receive Jesus himself; hospitality to Jesus' disciples will be rewarded.) Then encourage family members to talk about what it means to be a good guest or a good host. You might also talk about ways in which your family's hospitality might be improved upon. Conclude in prayer together that your family grows to be one in which Christian hospitality is experienced by all.

**READ TOGETHER**

Read together this Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 10:37-42 with your family.

**PRAY TOGETHER**

Pray together the Lord's Prayer or today's Psalm.



**Pastor's Family Corner**

**Decimotercero Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario ~ Año A  
Mateo 10:37-42**

Se puede saber mucho sobre una familia por la manera en que reciben a otros en su hogar. A pesar de los esfuerzos de los padres por lograr el mejor comportamiento de sus hijos, a veces es

difícil que la familia entretenga a los invitados. Practicar un espíritu de hospitalidad cristiana dentro de la familia puede ser una ocasión para reflexionar sobre la importancia de esta virtud. Un espíritu familiar de hospitalidad es un signo de fe.

**HABLEN JUNTOS**

Cuando tu familia se reúna, pide a cada persona que considere las siguientes preguntas sobre los modales: ¿Qué significa ser un buen anfitrión? ¿Qué significa ser un buen invitado? Invita a cada persona a compartir sus pensamientos y experiencias sobre ser un invitado o un anfitrión. Pide a los miembros de la familia que describan lo que Jesús dice sobre la hospitalidad hacia sus discípulos. (Aquellos que reciben a los discípulos de Jesús también reciben al mismo Jesús; la hospitalidad hacia los discípulos de Jesús será recompensada). Luego anima a los miembros de la familia a hablar sobre lo que significa ser un buen invitado o un buen anfitrión. También podrían conversar sobre formas en las que la hospitalidad de su familia podría mejorarse. Concluyan juntos en oración para que su familia crezca y sea un lugar donde todos experimenten la hospitalidad cristiana.

Recen juntos el Padre Nuestro o el Salmo de hoy.

## Month of the Precious Blood

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood.

"The Precious Blood which we worship is the Blood which the Savior shed for us on Calvary and reassumed at His glorious Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses through the veins of His risen, glorified, living body at the right hand of God the Father in heaven; it is the Blood made present on our altars by the words of Consecration; it's the Blood which merited sanctifying grace for us and through it washes and beautifies our soul and inaugurates the beginning of eternal life in it."

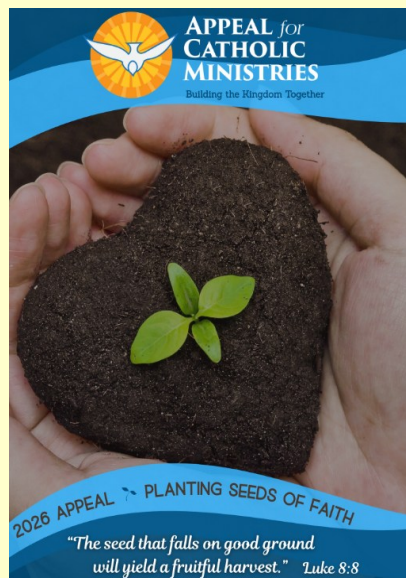

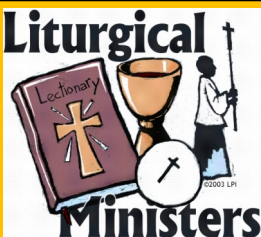
