## The Holy Trinity

Perhaps the deepest, the most profound of all mysteries is the mystery of the Trinity. The Church teaches us that although there is only one God, yet, somehow, there are three Persons in God. The Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God, yet we do not speak of three Gods, but only one God. They have the same nature, substance, and being. We came to know this immense mystery because Christ revealed it to us. Just before ascending He told them: "Go teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28:19). We know that these Three are not just different ways of looking at one person. For at the Last Supper, Jesus told us: "I came forth from the Father." So He is different from the Father. But He also promised: "If I go, I will send Him [the Paraclete] to you. . . . He will guide you to all truth" (John 16:28, 7, 13). So the Holy Spirit is also different. Even though the Three Persons are One God, yet they are distinct: for the Father has no origin, He came from no one. But the Son is begotten, He comes from the Father alone. The Holy Spirit comes or proceeds from both the Father and the Son. These different relations of origin tell us there are three distinct Persons, who have one and the same divine nature. Even though everything the Three Persons do outside the Divine nature is done by all Three, yet it is suitable that we attribute some works specially to one or the other Person. So we speak of the Father especially as the power of creation, of the Son as the wisdom of the Father, of the Holy Spirit as goodness and sanctification. The two doctrines of the Trinity and the Incarnation are the foundation of Christian life and worship. By becoming man, God the Son offered us a share in the inner life of the Trinity. By grace, we are brought into the perfect communion of life and love which is God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This sharing in the life of the Trinity is meant to culminate in heaven, where we will see the three Persons face to face, united to them in unspeakable love.



## La Santa Trinidad

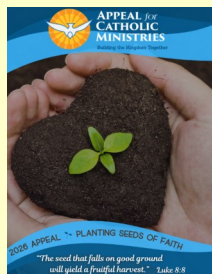

Quizás el más profundo, de todos los misterios es el misterio de la Trinidad. La Iglesia nos enseña que aunque hay un solo Dios, sin embargo, de alguna manera, hay tres Personas en Dios. El Padre es Dios, el Hijo es Dios, el Espíritu Santo es Dios, pero no hablamos de tres Dioses, sino de un solo Dios. Tienen la misma naturaleza, sustancia y ser. Llegamos a conocer este inmenso misterio porque Cristo nos lo reveló. Justo antes de ascender les dijo: "Id, pues, y haced discípulos a todas las gentes bautizándolas en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo" (Mateo 28:19). Sabemos que estos Tres no son solo formas diferentes de mirar a una persona. Porque en la Última Cena, Jesús nos dijo: "Salí del Padre". Así que Él es diferente del Padre. Pero también prometió: "Si me voy, os lo enviaré [el Paráclito] para ti... Él os guiará a toda la verdad" (Juan 16:28, 7, 13). Así también el Espíritu Santo es diferente. Aunque las Tres Personas son un solo Dios, sin embargo, son distintas: porque el Padre no tiene origen, Él vino de nadie, sino que el Hijo es engendrado, viene sólo del Padre, el Espíritu Santo viene o procede tanto del Padre como del Hijo. Estas diferentes relaciones de origen nos dicen que hay tres Personas distintas, que tienen una y la misma naturaleza divina. Aunque todo lo que hacen las Tres Personas fuera de la naturaleza divina lo hacen las Tres, sin embargo, es conveniente que atribuyamos algunas obras especialmente a una u otra Persona. Así hablamos del Padre especialmente como poder de creación, del Hijo como sabiduría del Padre, del Espíritu Santo como bondad y santificación. Las dos doctrinas de la Trinidad y la Encarnación son el fundamento de la vida y el culto cristiano. Al hacerse hombre, Dios Hijo nos ofreció una participación en la vida interior de la Trinidad. Por la gracia, somos llevados a la perfecta comunión de vida y amor que es Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Esta participación en la vida de la Trinidad debe culminar en el cielo, donde veremos a las tres Personas cara a cara, unidas a ellas en un amor inefable.

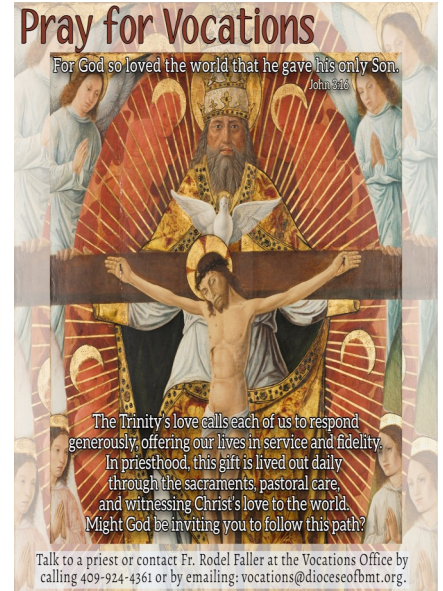


#### Safe Environment Compliance Required

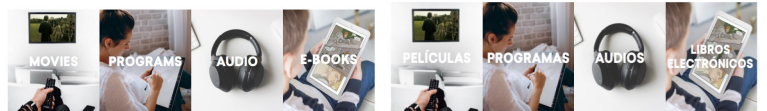
