**Twenty Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ Year A**  
**Matthew 18:21-35**

Children learn to trust God's mercy and forgiveness when they experience forgiveness from those closest to them. We hope that we model God's love and forgiveness within our family life. Today's Gospel reminds us that forgiveness is measured by its quality more than its quantity.

**TALK TOGETHER**

Invite your family to consider some recent times when family members sought the forgiveness of another. Ask if there were any statements made that put conditions on our forgiveness such as "I will play this game with you if you apologize for knocking over my blocks" or "I will accept your apology after you clean up your room." Do we sometimes "keep count" or put conditions on our forgiveness of one another? This is something we may be doing without realizing it. Ask if we sometimes find ourselves sounding like Peter, concerning ourselves with quantity of forgiveness rather than offering forgiveness abundantly and unconditionally. Reflect upon the parable that Jesus tells. What does the servant do that makes the king so angry? He refuses to forgive his fellow servant the debt that he owes. Because we have all received God's forgiveness, God expects that we will also be forgiving toward others. Jesus' answer to Peter's question is found at the end of the parable. The number of times that we forgive one another is less important than the depth of our forgiveness. We must forgive one another from the heart.

**READ TOGETHER**

Read together this Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 18:21-35.

**PRAY TOGETHER**

Conclude in prayer together that God's love and forgiveness is evident in your family life. Pray together today's psalm, Psalm 103, or the Lord's Prayer.



**Pastor's Family Corner**

**Vigésimo Cuarto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario ~ Año A**  
**Mateo 18:21-35**

Los niños aprenden a confiar en la misericordia y el perdón de Dios cuando experimentan el perdón por parte de quienes les son más cercanos. Esperamos que reflejemos el amor y el perdón de Dios dentro de nuestra vida familiar. El Evangelio

de hoy nos recuerda que el perdón se mide más por su calidad que por su cantidad.

**HABLEN JUNTOS**

Invita a tu familia a recordar algunos momentos recientes en los que algún miembro buscó el perdón de otro. Pregunta si se dijeron declaraciones que pusieran condiciones a nuestro perdón, como "Jugaré este juego contigo si te disculpas por derribar mis bloques" o "Aceptaré tu disculpa después de que limpies tu cuarto." ¿A veces 'hacemos cuentas' o ponemos condiciones al perdón hacia los demás? Esto es algo que tal vez hacemos sin darnos cuenta. Pregunta si algunas veces nos encontramos sonando como Pedro, preocupándonos por la cantidad de perdón en lugar de ofrecer perdón abundantemente y sin condiciones. Reflexiona sobre la parábola que cuenta Jesús. ¿Qué hace el siervo que enoja tanto al rey? Se niega a perdonar la deuda que su compañero le debe. Como todos hemos recibido el perdón de Dios, Dios espera que también seamos perdonadores con los demás. La respuesta de Jesús a la pregunta de Pedro se encuentra al final de la parábola. La cantidad de veces que nos perdonamos unos a otros es menos importante que la profundidad de nuestro perdón. Debemos perdonarnos de corazón.

**LEER JUNTOS**

Lean juntos con su familia el Evangelio de este domingo, Mateo 18:21-35.

**OREN JUNTOS**

Concluyan juntos en oración que el amor y el perdón de Dios son evidentes en la vida de su familia. Recen juntos el salmo de hoy, el Salmo 103, o el Padre Nuestro.

*"For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's."*  
 - ROMANS 14:8

This is the essence of stewardship – everything we have and everything we are is a gift from God. We aren't "owners" of anything, we are merely "stewards" of the gifts that God has given us, especially our very own lives. Pray to God, daily, and ask Him how He is calling you to live the life that He intended for you.

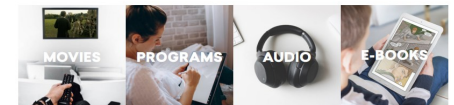
