





23rd Sunday In Ordinary Time - Matthew 18:15-20

Conflict and disagreements are a natural part of family life. Yet, within our family, we have an important opportunity to learn how to resolve disagreements fairly by treating people with love and respect.

As you gather as a family this week, discuss the procedures for resolving disputes in your family. What kinds of things produce disagreements in your family? Do children frequently request the assistance of the adults when a disagreement arises? How do the adults respond? In today's Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples the way in which they are to handle conflict within the Christian community of the Church. Read together this Gospel, Matthew 18:15-20. Invite family members to summarize the steps that Jesus proposes for resolving conflict. How might today's Gospel inform your family's handling of disagreements? If you have time, your family might choose to role play how Jesus' teaching about conflict resolution might be applied to a disagreement that sometimes occurs in your household.

In today's Gospel, Jesus also promises that he will help those who pray to him with their needs. Pray together that each member of your family will learn to handle conflict in a Christian manner. Pray together the Peace Prayer of Saint Francis.

“You, son of man, I have appointed watchman for the house of Israel...” (Ezekiel 33:7)

Many of us are generous with our gifts. However, many of us are not generous in proportion to the gifts we have been given. How often do we give at the minimum level required? Remember, the Lord calls us to nurture and develop our gifts. He calls us to be generous with all the gifts He has given us, especially the one that means the most to us.

Reading 1**Ez 33:7–8**

Thus says the LORD: You, son of man, I have appointed watchman for the house of Israel; when you hear me say anything, you shall warn them for me. If I tell the wicked, “O wicked one, you shall surely die,” and you do not speak out to dissuade the wicked from his way, the wicked shall die for his guilt, but I will hold you responsible for his death. But if you warn the wicked, trying to turn him from his way, and he refuses to turn from his way, he shall die for his guilt, but you shall save yourself.

Responsorial Psalm**Ps 95:1–2, 6–7, 8–9**

R. (8) If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

Come, let us sing joyfully to the LORD; let us acclaim the rock of our salvation. Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us joyfully sing psalms to him. **R.**

Come, let us bow down in worship; let us kneel before the LORD who made us. For he is our God, and we are the people he shepherds, the flock he guides. **R.** Oh, that today you would hear his voice: “Harden not your hearts as at Meribah, as in the day of Massah in the desert, Where your fathers tempted me; they tested me though they had seen my works.” **R.**

Reading 2**Rom 13:8–10**

Brothers and sisters: Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. The commandments, “You shall not commit adultery; you shall not kill; you shall not steal; you shall not covet,” and whatever other commandment there may be, are summed up in this saying, namely, “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” Love does no evil to the neighbor; hence, love is the fulfillment of the law.

Gospel**Mt 18:15–20**

Jesus said to his disciples: “If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother. If he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, so that ‘every fact may be established on the testimony of two or three witnesses.’ If he refuses to listen to them, tell the church. If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector. Amen, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again, amen, I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.”

Primera lectura**Ez 33, 7–9**

Esto dice el Señor: “A ti, hijo de hombre, te he constituido centinela para la casa de Israel. Cuando escuches una palabra de mi boca, tú se la comunicarás de mi parte. Si yo pronuncio sentencia de muerte contra un hombre, porque es malvado, y tú no lo amonestas para que se aparte del mal camino, el malvado morirá por su culpa, pero yo te pediré a ti cuentas de su vida. En cambio, si tú lo amonestas para que deje su mal camino y él no lo deja, morirá por su culpa, pero tú habrás salvado tu vida”.

Salmo Responsorial**Sal 94, 1–2. 6–7. 8–9**

R. (8) Señor, que nos seamos sordos a tu voz.

Vengan, lancemos vivas al Señor, aclamemos al Dios que nos salva. Acerquémonos a él, llenos de júbilo, y démosle gracias. **R.**

Vengan, y puestos de rodillas, adoremos y bendigamos al Señor, que nos hizo, pues él es nuestro Dios y nosotros, su pueblo, él nuestro pastor y nosotros, sus ovejas. **R.**

Hagámosle caso al Señor, que nos dice: “No endurezcan su corazón, como el día de rebelión en el desierto, cuando sus padres dudaron de mí, aunque habían visto mis obras”. **R.**

Segunda lectura**Rom 13, 8–10**

Hermanos: No tengan con nadie otra deuda que la del amor mutuo, porque el que ama al prójimo, ha cumplido ya toda la ley. En efecto, los mandamientos que ordenan: “No cometerás adulterio, no robarás, no matarás, no darás falso testimonio, no codiciarás” y todos los otros, se resumen en éste: “Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo”, pues quien ama a su prójimo no le causa daño a nadie. Así pues, cumplir perfectamente la ley consiste en amar.

Evangelio**Mt 18, 15–20**

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: “Si tu hermano comete un pecado, ve y amonestalo a solas. Si te escucha, habrás salvado a tu hermano. Si no te hace caso, hazte acompañar de una o dos personas, para que todo lo que se diga conste por boca de dos o tres testigos. Pero si ni así te hace caso, díselo a la comunidad; y si ni a la comunidad le hace caso, apártate de él como de un pagano o de un publicano. Yo les aseguro que todo lo que aten en la tierra, quedarán atados en el cielo, y todo lo que desaten en la tierra, quedarán desatados en el cielo. Yo les aseguro también, que si dos de ustedes se ponen de acuerdo para pedir algo, sea lo que fuere, mi Padre celestial se lo concederá; pues donde dos o tres se reúnen en mi nombre, ahí estoy yo en medio de ellos”.

Catecismo y preparación sacramental

La formación de fe debe hacerse dentro de las familias en el hogar en lugar de "en persona" en la parroquia en este momento. SAINT OF THE DAY

Saturday, September 5 ~ Saint Teresa of Calcutta

Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta was born in Albania, but is known for her work in India. A member of the Sisters of Loreto, she felt a call to live among the poor. While working with the poorest of the poor in India, she founded the Missionaries of Charity who continue her work.

Monday, September 7 ~ Blessed Frédéric Ozanam

Blessed Frédéric Ozanam proved to be a leader who helped others help the poor. He also formed a newspaper to push the cause of justice. In 1833, he founded the Saint Vincent de Paul Society, which continues to the present day.

Tuesday, September 8 ~ Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Affirming the humanity of Jesus, the Church celebrates the birth of Mary, his mother. While Scripture does not record the birth of Mary, the apocryphal Protoevangelium of James notes the development of Christian piety around Mary's parents and her birth.

Wednesday, September 9 ~ Saint Peter Claver

A native of Spain, young Jesuit Peter Claver left his homeland forever in 1610, to be a missionary in the colonies of the New World. He sailed into Cartagena, and began a ministry to the slaves brought there from West Africa, as well as becoming a moral force in the city of Cartagena.

Thursday, September 10 ~ Saint Thomas of Villanova

Saint Thomas was from Castile in Spain and received his surname from the town where he was raised. After joining the Augustinian friars at Salamanca, he became prior and then provincial of the friars. He sent the first Augustinian friars to the New World.

Friday, September 11 ~ Saint Cyprian

Saint Cyprian played an important role in the development of Christian thought and practice in the early Church. He was a noted speaker who became a Christian as an adult. He was ordained a priest within two years of his conversion and was then chosen the Bishop of Carthage.

SANTO DEL DIA

Sábado, 5 de septiembre ~ Santa Teresa de Calcuta

Teresa de Calcuta (1910-1997) fue una religiosa de origen albanés que se dedicó en cuerpo y alma a los pobres, enfermos, huérfanos y moribundos. En 1950 fundó la congregación de las *Misioneras de la Caridad* en Calcuta, India. Fue canonizada el 4 de septiembre de 2016 por el Papa Francisco I.

Lunes, 7 de septiembre ~ Bendito Frédéric Ozanam

El beato Frédéric Ozanam demostró ser un líder que ayudó a otros a ayudar a los pobres. También formó un periódico para impulsar la causa de la justicia. En 1833, fundó la Sociedad San Vicente de Paúl, que continúa hasta estos días.

Martes, 8 de septiembre ~ Natividad de la Santísima Virgen María

Afirmando la humanidad de Jesús, la Iglesia celebra el nacimiento de María, su madre. Si bien las Escrituras no registran el nacimiento de María, el Protoevangelio apócrifo de Santiago señala el desarrollo de la piedad cristiana alrededor de los padres de María y su nacimiento.

Miércoles, 9 de septiembre ~ S. Pedro Claver

Sacerdote de la Compañía de Jesús, San Pedro Claver pasó a la historia como uno de los más generosos misioneros de América meridional. Celebrado por la Iglesia el 9 de septiembre, trabajó durante más de 40 años en Colombia en favor de los africanos reducidos a esclavitud, bautizando a unos 300.000.

Jueves, 10 de septiembre ~ S. Tomás de Villanova

Santo Tomás era de Castilla en España y recibió su apellido de la ciudad donde se crió. Despues de unirse a los frailes agustinos en Salamanca, se convirtió en prior y luego provincial de los frailes. Envío a los primeros frailes agustinos al Nuevo Mundo.

Viernes, 11 de septiembre ~ S. Cipriano

San Cipriano jugó un papel importante en el desarrollo del pensamiento y la práctica cristianos en la Iglesia primitiva. Fue un orador destacado que se hizo cristiano de adulto. Fue ordenado sacerdote dos años después de su conversión y luego fue elegido obispo de Cartago.
