







**3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time- Matthew 4:12-23**

The readings of today tell us about the Christian vision and mission and are intended to stir us into action. The vision is seen in the proclamation of the kingdom of God to all people and the mission of every person is to proclaim the word of God to all. The Gospel of today tells us that the spread of Christ's kingdom depends as much upon us today as it did upon the Apostles during the time of Christ. The Good news that Jesus preaches is that people have to repent and change themselves as the kingdom of God is near. It is the good

news of hope, peace, promise, truth and salvation that is contained in the kingdom. Jesus comes to his people as the herald or the messenger of good news. His message of the kingdom has certainty and assurance; it has total authority and power because it comes from the source which is God himself. The Scriptures indicate that the kingdom of God existed at the foundation of the world. It is the authority of God over everything that he created for John tells us that everything was created in and through Jesus. The mission of Jesus now is to re-establish this divine kingdom. There is the immediacy and the urgency in his proclamation as he says it is here and now. The listener has to respond to it immediately without delay. At the same time Jesus emphatically tells us that he is the good news and we have the obligation to listen to him. Already at his Baptism the Father had made it clear that he was his beloved son and we ought to listen to him. Now Jesus himself preaches this kingdom for all and invites them to respond to him. To be in the kingdom, then, is not to be in a particular place, either in this life or the next. Rather it is to be living one's life, wherever we are, under the loving power of God. It is to be in a relationship of loving submission to one's God and Lord and to be in an environment where values like truth, love, compassion, justice, freedom, community, and peace prevail.

Just as Jesus called the first apostles, He calls each of us to follow Him, too. Not everyone is called to leave their business or family behind, but we are expected to put God first in everything. Everything from our time in daily prayer, our talent in participating in one of our parish ministries, and our treasure to support the financial needs of our parish mission.

## SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 2

**Luke 2:22–40 Simeon recognizes the infant Jesus as the promised Messiah.**

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Because Simeon and Anna lived lives of prayer and fasting in the Temple, they were filled with the Spirit of God. That is why they were able to identify Jesus as the Savior even though Jesus was only a baby. To these two holy people, he was recognizable as the Redeemer who had been promised. Simeon described Jesus as “a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel.”

We too are called to recognize Jesus as Lord. Together as a family discuss ways to recognize Jesus as Lord by praying and attending Mass, fasting, and serving others. As a family, decide on one specific sacrifice you can make in order to alleviate the suffering or need of someone you know.

## Quinceañera

The young lady's family must be registered, participating members of the parish for at least 1 year. "Participating members" are those who faithfully attend Mass and support the Church financially (using their contribution envelopes proving such). Ideally, they should also be active in the ministry, volunteering in the Church.

The young lady must attend CCE classes faithfully for at least 1 YEAR PRIOR to the Quinceañera. She must have received the sacrament of Baptism and she must make her First Holy Communion BEFORE the Quinceañera. She must be faithfully attending Confirmation preparation classes. She, along with her Sponsor, must attend all Quinceañera preparation classes.

Please call office at least 1 YEAR BEFORE any other arrangements are made and DO NOT set a final date for the Quinceañera prior to your interview with the priest.

**Quinceañera classes are held ONCE per year.**
