Fourth Sunday of Lent, Year A
John 9:1-41

When infants are baptized, parents, with the help of the godparents, assume responsibility for raising the child as a follower of Jesus. The process of maturation in the faith is much like the example found in the story of the man born blind. The man is cured of his blindness, a symbol of his sin. Each time he meets someone after the healing, the man comes to a deeper awareness of who Jesus is. In a similar way, we who are baptized continue to mature in faith as our relationship with and knowledge about Jesus grows.

TALK TOGETHER

Invite each member of your family to draw a timeline of his or her life. On the timelines, ask family members to identify significant moments in their lives, especially their life of faith. Invite each person to reflect upon who Jesus was to him or her at each significant moment. How has each person's relationship with Jesus changed or matured? Note how the relationship between Jesus and the man born blind changes and grows throughout the Gospel.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, John 9:1-41.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together that your relationship with Jesus will continue to grow and develop, becoming ever deeper. Conclude by praying together the Lord's Prayer.



Pastor's Family Corner

Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma, Año A
Juan 9:1-41

Cuando los bebés son bautizados, los padres, con la ayuda de los padrinos, asumen la responsabilidad de criar al niño como seguidor de Jesús. El proceso de maduración en la fe es muy parecido al ejemplo que se encuentra en la historia del hombre nacido ciego. El hombre es curado de su ceguera, un símbolo de su pecado. Cada vez que se encuentra con alguien después de la sanación, el hombre llega a una conciencia más profunda de quién es Jesús. De manera similar, nosotros que somos bautizados continuamos madurando en la fe a medida que nuestra relación con Jesús y nuestro conocimiento sobre Él crecen.

LEER JUNTOS

Invita a cada miembro de tu familia a dibujar una línea de tiempo de su vida. En las líneas de tiempo, pide a los miembros de la familia que identifiquen momentos significativos en sus vidas, especialmente en su vida de fe. Invita a cada persona a reflexionar sobre quién era Jesús para él o ella en cada momento significativo. ¿Cómo ha cambiado o madurado la relación de cada persona con Jesús? Observa cómo la relación entre Jesús y el hombre nacido ciego cambia y crece a lo largo del Evangelio.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Juan 9:1-41.

OREN JUNTOS

Recen juntos para que su relación con Jesús continúe creciendo y desarrollándose, volviéndose cada vez más profunda. Concluyan rezando juntos el Padre Nuestro.


