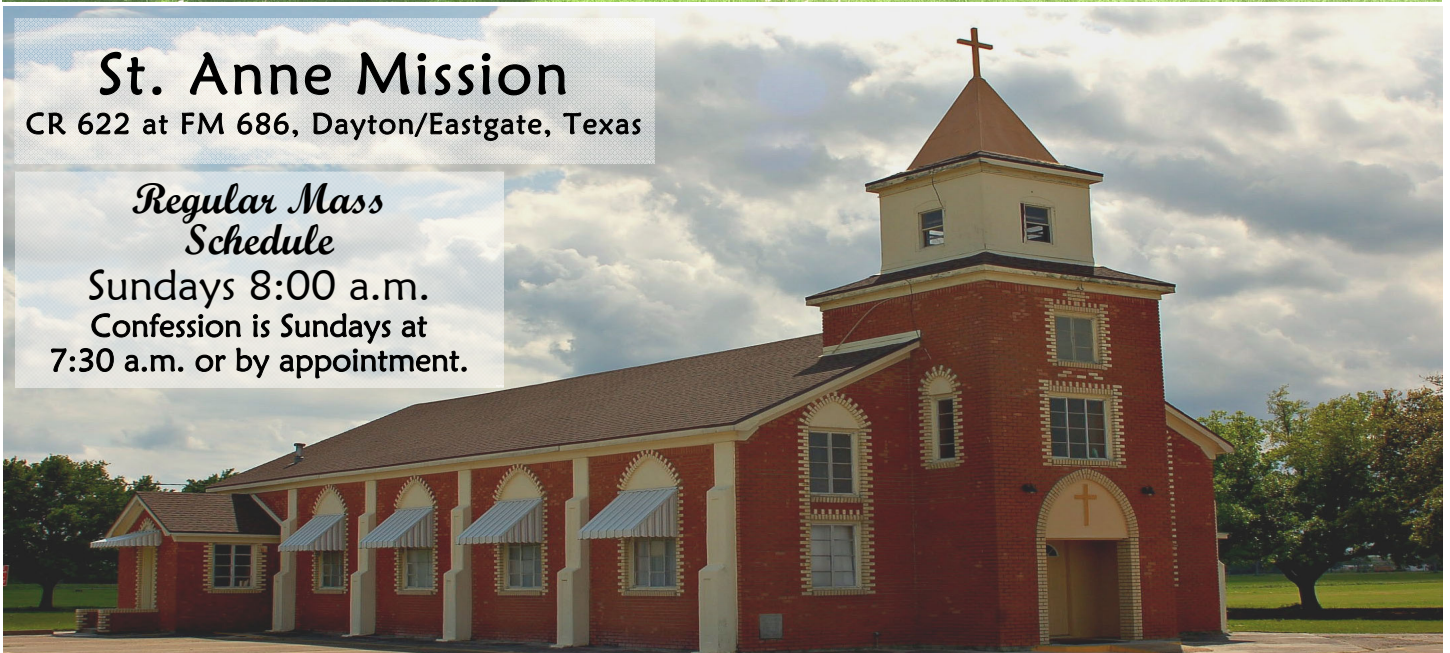

**Our Lord Jesus Christ the King of the Universe
John 18:33b-37**

Understanding today's feast of Christ the King may be particularly challenging. While most of us do not have direct experience with kings or royalty, we have a sense of who they are. We know that royalty have sovereignty over their kingdoms. We know that those who are subjects to royalty offer them allegiance and honor. To understand how Christ is our king, we extend and magnify what we know to be true of the best of human royalty. Christ's kingship extends to all places, all people, and all times. Christ manifests his kingship through his death on the cross in which he offered salvation to everyone. Those who can see with eyes of faith recognize Jesus to be our heavenly king.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, recall that this Sunday is the last Sunday in the Church year and on this Sunday we celebrate the feast of Christ the King. Talk together about what it means to be a king or queen. How do those who are subjects behave toward royalty? Invite children to role-play what one does in the presence of royalty.

READ TOGETHER

Ask your family to discuss these questions: Does Pilate treat Jesus like royalty? (No.) What does Jesus say about his kingdom? (It is not of this world.) Talk about how your family shows honor and obedience to Christ our King.

PRAY TOGETHER

The Lord's Prayer and ask God to help your family act in ways that show you recognize and honor Christ as King.



**Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo
Juan 18:33b-37**

Entender la fiesta de Cristo Rey de hoy puede ser particularmente desafiante. Si bien la mayoría de nosotros no tenemos experiencia directa con los reyes o la realeza, tenemos una idea de quiénes son. Sabemos que la realeza tiene soberanía sobre sus reinos. Sabemos que quienes son sujetos de la realeza les ofrecen lealtad y honor. Para comprender cómo Cristo es nuestro rey, ampliamos y magnificamos lo que sabemos que es verdad sobre lo mejor de la realeza humana. La realeza de Cristo se extiende a todos los lugares, a todas las personas y a todos los tiempos. Cristo manifiesta su realeza a través de su muerte en la cruz en la que ofreció la salvación a todos. Aquellos que pueden ver con ojos de fe reconocen que Jesús es nuestro rey celestial.

HABLAR JUNTOS

Al reunirse en familia, recuerden que este domingo es el último domingo del año de la Iglesia y este domingo celebramos la fiesta de Cristo Rey. Hablen juntos sobre lo que significa ser rey o reina. ¿Cómo se comportan los sujetos con la realeza? Invite a los niños a representar lo que se hace en presencia de la realeza.

LEER JUNTOS

Pídale a su familia que discuta estas preguntas: ¿Pilate trata a Jesús como a la realeza? (No.) ¿Qué dice Jesús acerca de su reino? (No es de este mundo). Hable sobre cómo su familia muestra honor y obediencia a Cristo nuestro Rey.

ORAR JUNTOS

El Padre Nuestro y pídale a Dios que ayude a su familia a actuar de manera que demuestre que reconoce y honra a Cristo como Rey.

Life is short. How much time, energy and money do you put into building "your" kingdom here on earth? We all know we can't take it with us. The real kingdom is in the next life. Yet, how much time, energy and money do you invest in working for that eternal kingdom? Ask God for His guidance. Detach from earthly possessions. Generously share your material goods with others for the greater glory of God.

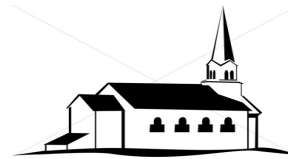
