Sixth Sunday In Ordinary, Year A Matthew 5:17-37

Families have rules. Without rules, family life would be chaos.

TALK TOGETHER

As a family, brainstorm a list of rules that you are all called to follow in your home in order for you all to get along together. Think about rules for play time, rules for eating, rules for how to speak to one another, rules for going out with friends, and so on. Emphasize that families follow rules as a way of showing love and respect for one another. Explain that in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus talks about following the Law. Say: God's Law of love can be thought of as rules that we are to follow in order to show our love and respect for one another. Talk specifically with one another about how anger is to be dealt with in your family.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, Matthew 5:17-37.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude by praying for the grace to overcome anger and to show respect for one another as a family by following God's Law of love.



Pastor's Family Corner

Sexto Domingo En El Tiempo Ordinario, Año A Mateo 5:17-37

Las familias tienen reglas. Sin reglas, la vida familiar sería un caos.

LEER JUNTOS

Como familia, hagan una lluvia de ideas para crear una lista de reglas que todos deban seguir en su hogar para poder llevarse bien entre ustedes. Piensen en reglas para la hora de jugar, reglas para comer, reglas sobre cómo hablarse unos a otros, reglas para salir con amigos, y así sucesivamente. Enfatiza que las familias siguen reglas como una manera de mostrar amor y respeto entre los miembros. Explica que en el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús habla sobre seguir la Ley. Di: La Ley de amor de Dios se puede pensar como reglas que debemos seguir para mostrar nuestro amor y respeto hacia los demás. Hablen específicamente entre ustedes sobre cómo debe manejarse la ira en su familia.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Mateo 5:17-37.

OREN JUNTOS

Concluye orando por la gracia de superar la ira y de mostrar respeto mutuo como familia siguiendo la Ley del amor de Dios.

"For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." MATTHEW 5:20



"Porque les digo a ustedes, no entrarán en el reino de Dios a menos que practiquen la justicia mejor que los escribas y los fariseos" MATEO 5:20

The Pharisees lived according to the letter of the law, and they used this to elevate themselves above the other people. Jesus is clear – it's the love that you have in your heart, for God and others, that will get you to heaven. Simply following church rules to the letter and not out of love, does not necessarily put you on the path to heaven. Attending Sunday Mass and then gossiping about a fellow parishioner on the parking lot is an example of being a modern-day Pharisee.

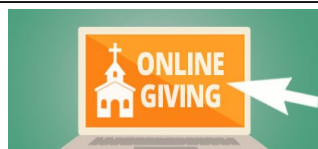

What is Lent?

The 40-day period from Ash Wednesday and before Easter Sunday. It is marked by praying, fasting, abstinence, and other acts of penance.

PRAYING FASTING ABSTINENCE



What is fasting?



One meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed one full meal

What is abstinence?



Abstinence is refraining from eating meat. Meat is considered to be the flesh and organs of mammals and fowl.

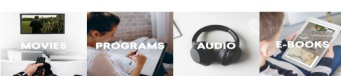

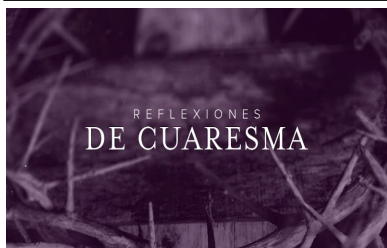

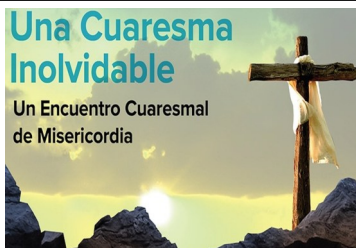
